# **Circumstances Surrounding Death**

On June 8, 2022, the 5-year-old passed away, along with her parents and an adult family friend, after being involved in a car accident while not being properly restrained.

According to the Florida Highway Patrol (FHP), the following information was provided. The FHP Sgt indicated they were not notified until 3:35 a.m. on June 8, 2022. The approximation of the times comes from cameras from the surrounding homes. The accident occurred at approximately 12:09 a.m.

The father was traveling southbound on CR-561 on a right-hand curve. For unknown reasons the car traveled onto the east grassy shoulder and collided with a large tree on the east shoulder. The impact caused the vehicle's rear to become airborne as it rotated clockwise before landing on top of a wire fence and fence post.

On June 8, 2022, Anthony Medina, Cristobal Lozada-Flores, and Emeleidy Rivera were pronounced deceased on scene at 3:46 a.m. Amarylliz Medina-Rivera was pronounced deceased on scene at 3:50 a.m.

The adults' seatbelts were found to be locked in place to stop the beeping prompt and the individuals were sitting on top of them. The child was not in a car seat as it was found on the floor in between the driver's seat and the second row.

The Florida Highway Patrol investigated the death of Amarylliz Medina-Rivera (FHP 220N0289285 / FHP 722-12-23). No arrests were made, nor charges filed, as all occupants were deceased.

The autopsy was received on December 8, 2022, and indicated District 5 Medical Examiner Shanedelle Norford, M.D., completed an autopsy of Amarylliz Medina-Rivera on June 9, 2022. ME# 22-05-01405.

Cause of Death: Blunt Head Trauma

Manner of Death: Accident

The child was negative for all substances.

On December 22, 2022, the Department of Children and Families' investigation was closed with:
