At approximately 3:45 PM [REDACTED] on 1/3/2022, [REDACTED] the stepfather, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were all present at a Pilot Gas Station off [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] County to conduct a child exchange. [REDACTED] the stepfather, and [REDACTED] presented to the child exchange with guns. During the child exchange there was an exchange of gun fire. There are limited details about the shooting such as who shot at who; however, [REDACTED] was shot in the neck, the stepfather was shot, and [REDACTED] was fatally shot. It is unknown if [REDACTED] was injured.

[REDACTED] and the stepfather were airlifted to [REDACTED] Center where they remain in critical condition. [REDACTED] injury is life threatening; it is unknown if she will survive. All the aforementioned information came from [REDACTED] Police Department Detective [REDACTED]

On January 4, 2022 the Department of Children's Services (DCS) received a referral with the allegation of severe Physical Abuse Preliminary Near Death concerning Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]: 16-years) with the Alleged Perpetrator listed as an Unknown Alleged Perpetrator. Allegations of Abuse Death and severe Lack of Supervision concerning [REDACTED] [REDACTED] were added with the Alleged Perpetrators being her parents, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and her stepfather, [REDACTED]. The investigation was assigned to Child Protective Services (CPS) by Team Leader (TL) [REDACTED]. The case was worked in conjunction with the [REDACTED] Police Department and Chief Deputy [REDACTED] and Detective (Det.) [REDACTED] [REDACTED].

At the time of the alleged incident [REDACTED] lived part time with her father, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and part time with her mother, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and stepfather, [REDACTED] [REDACTED].

On January 3, 2022, [REDACTED] Police Department was dispatched to a shooting at the Pilot off of [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] County, TN. The mother, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] the stepfather, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] father, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and ACV, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] were all present at a Pilot Gas Station off [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] County to conduct a child exchange. Mrs. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] came to the child exchange with guns. During the child exchange there was an exchange of gun fire. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was shot in the neck and airlifted to [REDACTED] Center, Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was shot, and airlifted to [REDACTED] Center, and Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was fatally shot. Mrs. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was not injured.

[REDACTED] [REDACTED] was pronounced deceased on January 6, 2022 at an unknown time. She was an organ donor and kept on life support until January 7, 2022. She was taken straight to the Medical Examiners office once her organs were harvested.

On January 4, 2022, CM [REDACTED] [REDACTED] interviewed [REDACTED] [REDACTED] mother. CM [REDACTED] [REDACTED] asked Mrs. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] if there were any other children in the home. Mrs. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was an only child. Mrs. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] [REDACTED] father, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] did not have any other children either. CM asked Mrs. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] what the custody agreement for [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was. Mrs. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] reported she was the primary parent and the father had something like every other weekend. Mrs. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] reported she didnt go to her fathers all the time; she was in band and so she wasnt always able to go to her fathers. lot and was another reason she did not go to her fathers. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] was a Junior in high school. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] attended [REDACTED] High School. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] was in the National Honor Society and taking dual enrollment classes at [REDACTED] Community College. CM asked Mrs. [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] had a plan for after high school. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] wanted to be a forensic scientist. CM [REDACTED] asked Mrs. [REDACTED] if she and the father got along with one another. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported whatever was in the court papers. CM [REDACTED] asked Mrs. [REDACTED] if she could tell her anything about what happened the day before during the custody exchange. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported I have been advised not to say anything. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported she has an attorney, [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] TN. CM [REDACTED] asked Mrs. [REDACTED] about her husband, [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported she and Mr. [REDACTED] have been together for 7 years. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported Mr. [REDACTED] was a preacher for [REDACTED] in [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported hes a good God-fearing man. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported I just dont understand why any of this happened, I am about to lose my best friend. CM [REDACTED] asked Mrs. [REDACTED] what the doctors were saying in regard to Mr. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported the prognosis was the same for both. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported there is little brain activity, they do not believe they will make it. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported Mr. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were her best friends. CM [REDACTED] expressed sympathy to the mother concerning the situation. CM [REDACTED] did ask Mrs. [REDACTED] if she would sign a release of information form in order to gather [REDACTED] records. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported do we have to do that right now, I dont want to do that, I have a lot right now. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported she expected to be at the hospital for awhile due to the injuries Mr. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] received. CM [REDACTED] reported she understood. CM [REDACTED] engaged Mrs. [REDACTED] about demographic information. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported she was unable to provide the address for the family as they have recently moved, and she did not know the address. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported the family moved a lot. On July 6, 2022 CM [REDACTED] was contacted by Det. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] Police Department and informed that [REDACTED] had been declared legally deceased but [REDACTED] Hospital would not provide the time of death. Det. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] is an organ donor and she will be left on life support until her organs are harvested on or about January 7, 2022. Det. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] will have an autopsy performed at the Regional Forensic Center.

On July 7, 2022 CM [REDACTED] was informed by Det. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] Police Department that the stepfather, [REDACTED] passed away. CM [REDACTED] was not able to request medical records from [REDACTED] Center due to the mother refusing to cooperate upon advice from legal counsel. [REDACTED] Police Department, OCS Safety Nurse, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] nor the Regional General Counsel, [REDACTED] where able to obtain the medical records. CM [REDACTED] was unable to engage the mother, [REDACTED] further after initial contact due to advise from legal counsel. CM [REDACTED] was unable to provide the mother, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with grief counseling services due to her seeking legal counsel.

On February 4, 2022, the mother, [REDACTED] did provide a statement with the presence of her attorney, [REDACTED] to Detective (Det.) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] Police Department and TBI Agent, [REDACTED]. The interview was audio recorded and typed notes were provided to CM [REDACTED] on August 29, 2022.

On August 25, 2022, CM [REDACTED] received a copy of the final autopsy on [REDACTED] [REDACTED] which was completed at the Regional Forensic Center, [REDACTED] TN by [REDACTED], MD, Assistant Medical Examiner. The autopsy was completed on January 10, 2022. The report states that [REDACTED] toxicology was negative for all substances. The cause of death was caused by a gunshot wound to the neck. The manner of death is determined to be homicide.

On August 19, 2022, CM [REDACTED] presented the allegations of Abuse Death against an Unknown Alleged Perpetrator, the mother, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] the stepfather, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and against the father, [REDACTED]

People present were Assistant District Attorney (ADA) [REDACTED], Youth Services Officer with [REDACTED] County Juvenile Court, [REDACTED], Detective (Det.) [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] Police Department, Chief of Police with the [REDACTED] Police Department, [REDACTED] Team Leader (TL) [REDACTED] Det. [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] County Sheriff's Department, and [REDACTED] Children's Advocacy Center (CAC) [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED]. CM [REDACTED] Det. [REDACTED] and Chief [REDACTED] all presented the facts of the case in that during a child exchange of the deceased ACV [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] was shot in the neck later passing away at [REDACTED] Center as a result of the gunshot wound. It was discussed that all 3 of the adults, the mother, stepfather, and father all had firearms in their possession, and it is unclear who started the altercation but the father, Mr. [REDACTED] was shot 6 times. It was also reported that the mother, [REDACTED] shot Mr. [REDACTED] again after he was down, and that the stepfather, [REDACTED] was shot and later passed away at [REDACTED] Center. The mother, [REDACTED] is the only one who wasn't injured. Chief [REDACTED] reported that the mother was in a position based on video they observed to have moved [REDACTED] out of the way but did not. Mr. [REDACTED] was found to have multiple firearms and magazines in his possession as well. In the video, the father pulled away, but it appeared that something was said to him as he was leaving, came back, and that is when the gunfire began. The autopsy was discussed as it was determined that [REDACTED] died as a result of a gunshot wound to the neck and manner of death was determined to be homicide. The team agreed to close the case. The majority agreed to classify the allegations of severe Lack of Supervision and Abuse Death against the father, stepfather, and mother as Allegation Substantiated/Alleged Perpetrator Substantiated. YSO [REDACTED] and ADA [REDACTED] disagreed with substantiating the mother, [REDACTED]. All others agreed. The team agreed to classify the allegations of Physical Abuse and Abuse Death against an Unknown Alleged Perpetrator as Allegation Unsubstantiated/Alleged Perpetrator Unsubstantiated. There will be no prosecution and no services due to the mother failing to cooperate with DCS during the investigation and due to no other children being in the home.

Per DCS Policy Work Aid 1 Section C:

Lack of Supervision:

Failure to provide adequate supervision, by a parent or other legal custodian/caretaker, who is able to do so. A lack of supervision allegation or determination means that:

- a) The child has been placed in a situation that requires actions beyond the child's level of maturity, physical ability, and/or mental ability; or
- b) Caregiver inadequately supervises a child. The caregiver is with the child, but is unable or unwilling to supervise (e.g., the caregiver is under the influence of alcohol or drugs, is depressed, sleeps during the day or has inadequate parenting knowledge or skills).
- c) Any registered sex offender residing in the home with unrelated minor children or victim of offender and/or caregiver knowingly resides with and/or allows children to be unsupervised with a registered sex offender.

Per DCS Policy Work Aid 1 Section G:

Child death is defined as:

- a) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect.
- b) Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report.
- c) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect resulting from the parent or legal custodian/caretaker failure to stop another person's direct action that resulted in the death of the child. Child deaths are always treated as severe abuse.

2. A near death, per Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA) 37-5-107(c)(4) is defined as a serious or critical medical condition resulting from abuse, neglect or child sexual abuse, as reported by a physician who has examined the

child subsequent to the abuse or neglect. When an initial referral or a referral on an open case contains information that suggests the child is in a serious or critical medical condition as a result of the allegation(s) or has been determined to meet the criteria for an allegation of near death as defined above, the Child Abuse Hotline selects Preliminary Near Death (PND) Indicator in TFACTS on the participants tab on a new intake or the investigative persons tab on an active case. The information does not have to come from a physician. Preliminary near deaths are always treated as severe child abuse. There is a preponderance of evidence to support the allegations of Abuse Death and severe Lack of Supervision against [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. People present were Assistant District Attorney (ADA) [REDACTED], Youth Services Officer with [REDACTED] County Juvenile Court, [REDACTED], Detective (Det.) CM asked Mrs. [REDACTED] what the custody agreement for [REDACTED] was. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported she was the primary parent and the father had "something like every other weekend". Mrs. [REDACTED] reported "she didn't go to her father's all the time; she was in band and so she wasn't always able to go to her father's". Mrs. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] also went bowling with her friends a lot and was another reason she did not go to her father's. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] was a Junior in high school. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] attended [REDACTED] High School.
