and reported that they left the residence together to go to Taco Bell at around 1:35 am on March 27, 2022. The properties and reported they were gone no longer than 15 minutes. The children were left in the care of at the residence during this time. The incident occurred in the master bedroom of the residence which is located at end of the hall to the left. Said that was in the bedroom with at the time of the shooting, but no adult was present in the room. The firearms were in the room with the children prior to the incident occurring but their exact location in bedroom is unknown. The weapons are believed to have been loaded.

A search warrant was conducted at the home by law enforcement. The search revealed two AR-15 guns and a handgun located in the back yard of the residence. Per DCS Policy 14, Work Aid 1, Section G:

Child Death is defined as:

a) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect. b) Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report. c) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect resulting from the parent or legal custodian/caretaker failure to stop another persons direct action that resulted in the death of the child. Child deaths are always treated as severe abuse.

#### Lack of Supervision:

Failure to provide adequate supervision, by a parent or other legal custodian/caretaker, who is able to do so. A lack of supervision allegation or determination means that:

- a) The child has been placed in a situation that requires actions beyond the childs level of maturity, physical ability, and/or mental ability; or
- b) Caregiver inadequately supervises a child. The caregiver is with the child, but is unable or unwilling to supervise (e.g., the
