An autopsy is pending. The parents reported leaving their other three children home alone when they left for the hospital with PD contacted PD for request to complete a welfare check on the children once this information was learned, with the check occurring at approximately 8:30am on 6/23/22 at the family home. The two oldest siblings opened the door for LE after communicating with them through a window. LE reported a strong smell of marijuana in the home as well as trash, filth and roaches. Additionally, it was noted the home had been blacked out with garbage bags over the windows. Roaches were observed in the bassinet where was found. CM observed the home and described it as unclean but likely the issues could have been resolved through services; however, it was noted a bathroom and bedrooms were painted black from ceiling to floor and windows, including the toilet. CM noted an extremely strong smell of marijuana in the home. A locked room was accessed by LE through a search warrant and marijuana was found inside. Marijuana roaches were observed in the garage and in the parents toilet. CM photographed a paper on the parents bed with instructions on how to perform CPR. was checked by EMS. She appeared lethargic, with low grade temperature. All of the children were medically cleared at had multiple injuries to her skull, which appeared new and old. She underwent immediate surgery to reduce the bleeds on her brain and swelling. A bruise was noted on and behind ear and disconnected frenulum. The injuries were consistent with

non-accidental trauma. The older siblings did not have breaks or older injuries, but the 3yo did have marks on her lower back. The oldest sibling, reported the parents did not tell her they were leaving, and she woke up to find them gone. She reported the parents would spank the babies with their hands because they wanted them to eat. Forensic Interviews were completed with the oldest two siblings, but there were no disclosures of concern during those interviews. The parents were arrested for aggravated child abuse and neglect. The parents were unable to provide any relatives within Tennessee to assume care for the surviving siblings, so they were brought into state custody.

Next Steps:

- -- CM will request medical records for the deceased ACV and all the children, to include birth, PCP, and current incident. Records will be reviewed and uploaded to TFACTS.
- -- CM will request all interviews and information/evidence collected by LE within their investigation and review, summarize, and upload what is shared to TFACTS.

- -- CM will request Clearsearch on the parents.
- -- CM will consult with DA regarding hair follicles for the parents through court order and no contact with the parents and children.
- -- CM will request hair follicles for the children.
- -- CM will request child welfare records from Arkansas.
- -- CPSD will speak with ME regarding toxicology/drug screen on ACV.
- -- CM will request school records for oldest sibling in Arkansas.
- -- CM will follow with legal on the pending petition.
- -- CM will document and upload autopsy into TFACTS once received.
- -- CM will complete Closing FAST prior to case closure.
- -- CM will present findings to the Child Protective Investigative Team (CPIT) for classification review.
