Sergeant [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] Police Department contacted the [REDACTED] Police Department for the welfare check. Sergeant [REDACTED] is at [REDACTED] with the children's parents. Sergeant [REDACTED] informed officers that the parents took [REDACTED] twin sibling (name unknown) to the hospital for breathing problems, but the child had a black eye and bloody nose. The child is deceased. It is believed that the child was deceased when it arrived at the hospital with the parents, but that cannot be confirmed. Sergeant [REDACTED] advised that the child's death is an active homicide investigation. The parents are believed to be suspects in the child's death. The parents have been at the [REDACTED] since 1:00 am.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] opened the door for officers after communicating through a window. Officers observed a very obvious smell of marijuana, trash, and filth. The entire home is blacked out. All the

windows have garbage bags on them. The kitchen is in disarray and there is stuff everywhere. There are roaches in the home. [REDACTED] was found in a bassinet with roaches inside of it. The entire home is in disarray and nasty. EMS is on scene to examine [REDACTED] appears to be healthy.

[REDACTED] does not like the police and he will not cooperate. [REDACTED] had a child was passed away in Arkansas after being left in a bus and it died of heat exhaustion. [REDACTED] won a lawsuit from the child's death. [REDACTED] has alarms and cameras all around his building and at one point, he had painted everything outside of his home black. Immediate assistance is being requested to the residence.

On June 23, 2022, the Department of Children's Services (DCS) received a referral for an allegation of Abuse Death regarding Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] (7 months old). The Alleged Perpetrators (APs) was listed as [REDACTED] and Unknown Participant at the time of the referral. The referral also listed the allegation of Environmental Neglect regarding Alleged Child Victims (ACVs) [REDACTED] (7 months old), [REDACTED] (3 years old), and [REDACTED] (7 years old). The Alleged Perpetrators (APs) are listed as [REDACTED] and Unknown Participant. This investigation was assigned to Child Protective Services Case Manager (CM) [REDACTED] by Lead Investigator (TL) [REDACTED]. This case was worked in conjunction with [REDACTED] Police Department (PD) Officer, [REDACTED].

All 4 children ([REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED]) lived at home with their birth mother, [REDACTED] and birth father, [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] Tennessee.

On June 23, 2022, officers with the [REDACTED] Police Department responded to the family's residence for a welfare check on the children. Sergeant [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] Police Department contacted the [REDACTED] Police Department for the welfare check due to the child, [REDACTED] being brought to [REDACTED] Hospital in [REDACTED] Tennessee by the parents, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. It is reported that the other siblings ([REDACTED] and [REDACTED]) were home alone at the residence in [REDACTED] Tennessee. It is reported that [REDACTED] was brought to the hospital due to breathing problems but was observed to have a black eye and bloody nose. It is reported that [REDACTED] was pronounced deceased at the hospital upon arrival at approximately 1:00 am. After arriving at the residence, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] opened the door for officers and the officers observed a smell of marijuana, trash, and filth. The entire home is blacked out. All windows have garbage bags on them. The kitchen is in disarray and there is stuff everywhere. There are roaches in the home. [REDACTED] was found in the bedroom in a bassinet with roaches inside of it. No adults were at the residence at the time of officers arrival.

Mr. [REDACTED] was unable to be interviewed as he was arrested prior to Case Manager (CM) [REDACTED] and CM [REDACTED] arrival to the family's residence. Mrs. [REDACTED] was spoken with briefly to attempt to locate non-custodial placement for the children; however, Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that she did not have any family. Mrs. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was arrested and taken into police custody. Officers requested that CM [REDACTED] not ask any further questions other than placement options for the children. CM [REDACTED] and CM [REDACTED] noticed [REDACTED] had an irregular head shape and was eerily quiet for a 7-month-old. [REDACTED] did not cry nor make a sound in the 40 minutes CM [REDACTED] and CM [REDACTED] were at the residence. EMS stated that they had looked over [REDACTED] and did not have concerns; however, reported that [REDACTED] did not make any noise while they were assessing her. CM [REDACTED] and CPS [REDACTED] transported the three living children ([REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]) to [REDACTED] Childrens Hospital.

Dr. [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] Childrens Hospital was interviewed on June 28, 2022. Dr. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] was sent to Neurology for a brain bleed and states that there was fresh blood in the back of [REDACTED] head, indicative of non-accidental trauma. Due to [REDACTED] brain injury, she is being sent to Audiology to check on her hearing on June 30, 2022. Dr. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] will also have follow up appointments with Neurology and trauma in two weeks due to her injuries. Dr. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] injuries were severe and was not able to be caused from [REDACTED] herself. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were not noted to have any physical injuries. [REDACTED] will be discharged from the hospital on June 29, 2022. All three children ([REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]) are in DCS custody.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] completed a forensic interview on June 24, 2022. Neither child made a disclosure of abuse.

On June 23, 2022, an autopsy was completed on [REDACTED] [REDACTED] by Dr. [REDACTED], Regional Forensics Center, [REDACTED] TN. The Cause of Death is Blunt Head Trauma, and Manner of Death is Homicide.

On November 08, 2023, CM [REDACTED] presented this case to the [REDACTED] County Child Protective Investigative Team (CPIT). Those in attendance were CPS [REDACTED], CPS TL [REDACTED], LE [REDACTED], DA [REDACTED], CAC [REDACTED], Mental Health: [REDACTED], Other (medical) [REDACTED], and Other: [REDACTED]. The team was in agreement that there was a preponderance to support the allegation of Abuse Death regarding ACV [REDACTED]. The team was in agreement that there was a preponderance to support the allegation of Physical Abuse regarding ACV [REDACTED].

Per DCS Policy Work Aid 1 Section E:

Child Death is defined as:

- a) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect.
- b) Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report.
- c) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect resulting from the parent or caretakers failure to stop another persons direct action that resulted in the death of the child. Child deaths are always treated as severe abuse.

There is a preponderance of evidence to support the allegation of Abuse Death. This case will be closed and classified as Allegation Substantiated, Perpetrator Substantiated for the Abuse Death of [REDACTED]. An internal meeting was held with Mr. And Mrs. [REDACTED] to address leaving the state with the girls over the holidays. The relatives reported they went to the maternal grandparent's home for [REDACTED] but stated they did not have contact with the mother. They reported not knowing they could not leave the state with the children. FSW advised that any future out of state travel needs to be submitted to FSW in advance and FSW would submit that to upper management to be signed off on. FSW would then send them a form with approvals that the relatives would need to take with them. They reported understanding. TL [REDACTED] addressed ground rules and legal addressed the children having no contact with mom whatsoever. The team also addressed supervision with TX ICPC. TX ICPC reports never receiving the 100Bs and not knowing the children were placed in TX. TN ICPC confirmed these were sent on the date of placement, resent the 100Bs, and asked TX ICPC to see the children immediately.

When the team met with the father, he had no comments regarding DCSs involvement but wanted the children to know that he loved them very much and that he would be back home soon. (The mother and father participated at separate times due to them both being incarcerated). The team was advised that the child [REDACTED] was born prematurely. According to DCS Health Unit Nurse ([REDACTED] [REDACTED]) placement with Ms. [REDACTED] is specified as a child with special health care needs. Ms. [REDACTED] informed the team that [REDACTED] did well the first night in her home. Ms. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] was fed 6oz of formula every 4 to 5 hours.

The Abuse Death investigation regarding Alleged Child Victim (ACV) ██████████ was debriefed with Case Managers (CM) ██████████ and ██████████ and Team Leader (TL) ██████████. Also present was Team Coordinator (TC) ██████████, CPS Director (CPSD) ██████████, and Director of Critical Incident Support (DCIS) ██████████.

The CPS investigation was assigned on 6/23/22 concerning the death of ACV ██████████ (7mo). It was reported ██████████ resided with his birth mother ██████████ birth father ██████████ and three siblings ██████████ 7mo/twin, ██████████ 3yo, and ██████████ 7yo] in ██████████ County.

On 6/23/22 it was reported the parents had taken ██████████ to the ER of the ██████████ Medical in ██████████ by private vehicle at approximately midnight, due to breathing problems ██████████ was observed with a black eye and bloody nose and it was believed he was deceased upon arrival the hospital. An autopsy is pending. The parents reported leaving their other three children home alone when they left for the hospital with ██████████ PD contacted ██████████ PD for request to complete a welfare check on the children once this information was learned, with the check occurring at approximately 8:30am on 6/23/22 at the family home. The two oldest siblings opened the door for LE after communicating with them through a window. LE reported a strong smell of marijuana in the home as well as trash, filth and roaches. Additionally, it was noted the home had been blacked out with garbage bags over the windows. Roaches were observed in the bassinet where ██████████ was found. CM observed the home and described it as unclean but likely the issues could have been resolved through services; however, it was noted a bathroom and bedrooms were painted black from ceiling to floor and windows, including the toilet. CM noted an extremely strong smell of marijuana in the home. A locked room was accessed by LE through a search warrant and marijuana was found inside. Marijuana roaches were observed in the garage and in the parents toilet. CM photographed a paper on the parents bed with instructions on how to perform CPR. ██████████ was checked by EMS. She appeared lethargic, with low grade temperature. All of the children were medically cleared at ██████████, where it was discovered, ██████████ had multiple injuries to her skull, which appeared new and old. She underwent immediate surgery to reduce the bleeds on her brain and swelling. A bruise was noted on and behind ██████████ ear and disconnected frenulum. The injuries were consistent with

non-accidental trauma. The older siblings did not have breaks or older injuries, but the 3yo did have marks on her lower back. The oldest sibling, [REDACTED] reported the parents did not tell her they were leaving, and she woke up to find them gone. She reported the parents would spank the babies with their hands because they wanted them to eat. Forensic Interviews were completed with the oldest two siblings, but there were no disclosures of concern during those interviews. The parents were arrested for aggravated child abuse and neglect. The parents were unable to provide any relatives within Tennessee to assume care for the surviving siblings, so they were brought into state custody.

- CPSD will speak with ME regarding toxicology/drug screen on ACV.
- CM will request school records for oldest sibling in Arkansas.
- CM will follow with legal on the pending petition.
- CM will document and upload autopsy into TFACTS once received.
- CM will complete Closing FAST prior to case closure.
- CM will present findings to the Child Protective Investigative Team (CPIT) for classification review.
