The allegation of Domestic Violence naming as the ACVs and as the AP has also been classified as ASPS. During a domestic violence incident, was fatally wounded by Mr. when attempted to save his mother, who was being attacked by Mr. Ms. was also killed during this incident. It is reported there had been a history of domestic violence. The CPIT members agree with the classification, and the CPIT forms have been uploaded in TFACTS. and entered DCS custody, but have exited via ICPC to the custody of their aunt who lives out of state. The closing summary has been reviewed and approved. The closing FAST has been completed with the following results: Immediate Intervention Not Recommended, Moderate Need/Risk. The 740 has been completed and will be forwarded to Juvenile Court Judge and District Attorney for classification. Team Leader has reviewed the case file and is approving the investigation for closure.
