Law enforcement was called out to the family neighbor's (names unknown) home on 9/25/2022 regarding a drowning. The neighbors stated that they found a child in their pool at approximately 1:30pm. The child that was later identified as [REDACTED]. The neighbor stated that [REDACTED] and his family reside next door to them. It is unknown how long [REDACTED] was in the pool before neighbors observed him. After [REDACTED] was found in the pool, the neighbor ran to the family home and the door was open and [REDACTED] was found asleep in the back bedroom. [REDACTED] was not present because she left the home at 6am to go to work. [REDACTED] was spoken with, and he stated that the last time that he saw the [REDACTED] was at 9:15am. It is believed that [REDACTED] was asleep from 9:15am until the neighbor knocked on his door sometime after 1:30pm.

The neighbor stated that this was not the first time that the [REDACTED] has been found roaming around outside by himself. It is unknown when the other times occurred. Each time this occurred [REDACTED] was supposed to be watching [REDACTED] was transported to [REDACTED] Hospital. [REDACTED] was not breathing when he was transported and there are no recent updates about [REDACTED] condition. Law enforcement reported that [REDACTED] "did not look well when he was transported to the hospital". It is unknown if there were any observable injuries on [REDACTED] on 9/25/2022. The family's home was described as "a complete mess" by law enforcement. The home was described as "very dirty and unorganized". [REDACTED] has another unknown child, but that child does not reside at the home with the family. There is no cell phone service in the area where the family resides. The police report number is [REDACTED].

On September 25, 2022, the Department of Children's Services (DCS) received a referral for an allegation of Abuse Death and Lack of Supervision regarding Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (2 years old). The Alleged Perpetrator (AP) was identified as birth father [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. This investigation was assigned to Child Protective Services Case Manager (CM) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] by Team Leader (TL) [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. This case was worked in conjunction with Sergeant, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] County Sheriffs Office.

[REDACTED] [REDACTED] lived at home with his birth mother, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and birth father, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

On September 25, 2022, [REDACTED] County Sheriffs Department responded to the home of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] due to a reported drowning as a two-year-old child was found unresponsive in their pool at approximately 1:30 PM. The identity of the child was determined to be Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who was a neighbor. Upon identifying the child and going to the child's home, the front door was found open and the father of Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was located asleep in the back bedroom. Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that the last time he recalls seeing Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was around 9:15 AM before Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] went to sleep. The mother [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was not present during the time of the incident and was reported to have left for work at 6:00 AM. The family's home was described as a complete mess and very dirty and unorganized.

On September 25, 2022, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] birth father of ACV [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was interviewed at the family home. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] [REDACTED] woke up around 5:45 AM to go to work at McDonalds and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] woke up shortly after Ms. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] departure. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] advised that he got up with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and sat on the couch to watch his favorite movie Curious George. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] advised that he went and laid down in his bedroom while [REDACTED] [REDACTED] continued to watch his movie for about a half an hour. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that he had gotten off work at 12:30 AM the night before and did not go to bed until about 1:00 AM. He stated that [REDACTED] [REDACTED] typically wakes up around 7:00 or 8:00 AM. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] recently learned how to unlock the door and the family has

not had an opportunity to buy child safety locks. [REDACTED] has gotten out of the home one other time, but he was in the care of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and he did not know all the circumstances regarding that incident.

On September 25, 2022 [REDACTED] [REDACTED], birth mother to ACV [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was interviewed at [REDACTED] Hospital. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] reported that she woke up around 5:45 AM to get ready for work, she kissed [REDACTED] goodbye before departing the family home as she must be at work at 6:00 AM. She stated that [REDACTED] was left in the care of his birth father [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who always watches [REDACTED] while she is at work. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that she received a phone call from her sister at 1:30 PM asking if the things being posted about [REDACTED] on social media was true. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that she left work around 1:35 PM and went home. She reported that [REDACTED] had previously gotten out of the home on three previous occasions as he has learned to unlock the door. [REDACTED] was in the care of Mr. [REDACTED] on the first incident and in her care on the second incident of him getting out of the home. They planned on buying safety locks when she got paid next Tuesday. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] denied that any illegal substance use. She is unaware of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] morning routine due to her work schedule. She tries to put [REDACTED] to bed around 10:00 PM so that she can be in bed by 11:00 PM. [REDACTED] typically sleeps in the bed with her and Mr. [REDACTED] but they have been trying to get [REDACTED] to sleep in his own bedroom but [REDACTED] would come get in the bed with them around 2:00 AM.

On September 25, 2022 [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was taken to [REDACTED] Hospital Emergency Room. He was unresponsive and several medical professionals were working on [REDACTED] to keep him stabilized. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was later pronounced deceased by Dr. [REDACTED] at 10:15 PM.

On September 25, 2022, Sergeant [REDACTED] [REDACTED] County Sheriffs Office, reported that several neighbors were interviewed and reported that [REDACTED] had gotten out of the home on multiple occasions (approximately 5-9 times) prior to the reported incident while in the care of both parents. Sergeant [REDACTED] advised that neither parent was aware of [REDACTED] being out of the home during the previous incidents and were not actively looking for him.

On September 25, 2022 Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (owner of the residence and pool where Alleged Child Victim, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was located) was interviewed and reported that the [REDACTED] family rents from him. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that he had looked out of the window to check the pool and saw [REDACTED] floating in the pool. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] reported removing [REDACTED] from the pool and other neighbors began performing cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) on [REDACTED]

On September 27, 2022, an autopsy was completed on [REDACTED] [REDACTED] by Dr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED], Regional Forensic Center, [REDACTED] TN. The autopsy stated, This is a two-year-old white male child, discovered face down in a neighbors above ground swimming pool. The child was in the custody of his father who took an afternoon nap. This enabled the child to exit the residence and end up in the swimming pool. The child did not know how to swim. Based on the initial scene investigation and the complete autopsy with ancillary studies, the main cause of death to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] is drowning. The manner of death is consistent with accident despite the fact that this was an unwitnessed drowning.

On March 20, 2023 [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was arrested and charged with aggravated child neglect and criminally negligent homicide in the death of [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

- b) Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report.
- c) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect resulting from the parent or caretakers failure to stop another persons direct action that resulted in the death of the child. Child deaths are always treated as severe abuse.

Per policy and Work Aid 1 Section C:

Lack of Supervision is defined as:

Failure to provide adequate supervision, by a parent or other caretaker, who is able to do so. A lack of supervision allegation or determination means that:

- a) The child has been placed in a situation that requires actions beyond the childs level of maturity, physical ability, and/or mental ability; or
- b) Caregiver inadequately supervises a child. The caregiver is with the child but is unable or unwilling to supervise (e.g., the caregiver is under the influence of alcohol or drugs, is depressed, sleeps during the day, or has inadequate parenting knowledge or skills)
- c) Any registered sex offender residing in a home with unrelated minor children or victim of offender, and/or caregiver knowingly resides with and/or allows children to be unsupervised with a registered sex offender.

There is a preponderance of evidence that supports the substantiation for all allegations against AP [REDACTED]

CM received case summary/witness statements from Sergeant [REDACTED] [REDACTED] of the [REDACTED] County Sheriff's office on this date and time. CM observed the summary to state Sgt. [REDACTED] interviewed Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and Mrs. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] whose property and pool [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (decedent) was found in. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that she was sitting on the front porch smoking a cigarette when she heard her husband Mr. [REDACTED] yelling that a child was in their pool. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported observing the child in the pool face down and calling 911. Dispatch provided CPR instructions and several neighbors were reported to come to assist. Mr. and Mrs. [REDACTED] advised that the [REDACTED] family rents from them. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that looked out of the window to check the pool and saw [REDACTED] floating in the pool. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that it was the first time he had checked the pool for the day. Mr. [REDACTED] reported removing [REDACTED] from the pool and others performing CPR. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that when he pulled the child from the pool he was not wearing anything.

Detective [REDACTED] of the [REDACTED] County Sheriff's Office interviewed neighbor [REDACTED] [REDACTED] on September 25, 2022. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that she contacted [REDACTED] aunt [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (maternal aunt). Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that she began doing CPR on [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] was cold to the touch, blue lips, and his pupils had expanded. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that she thought [REDACTED] diaper had disintegrated and parts of it were in his mouth. Mrs. [REDACTED] advised that she pulled material out of [REDACTED] mouth. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported seeing the door to the [REDACTED] residence standing open. Mrs. [REDACTED] continued CPR until EMS arrived. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that since the family has lived in the residence [REDACTED] has gotten out of the home around 7 times.

Det. [REDACTED] interviewed Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] husband to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] on September 25, 2022. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he and Mrs. [REDACTED] daughter was at the [REDACTED] residence playing when Mrs. [REDACTED] came running to their home stating they found [REDACTED] floating dead in the pool. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he and Mrs. [REDACTED] went back to the residence and Mr. [REDACTED] pulling [REDACTED] out of the pool. Mr. [REDACTED] reported seeing brown mush in [REDACTED] mouth. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he did not observe [REDACTED] breathing. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he went to the [REDACTED] residence and began yelling for someone but no one answered. Mr. [REDACTED] advised that he went back to the bedroom and continued to yell. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was

in the bedroom with the door shut and the lights out. Mr. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] has gotten out of the home several times and neighbors have to look for him. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that another neighbor found [REDACTED] outside at midnight before.

Sgt. [REDACTED] interviewed [REDACTED] on September 26, 2022. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that she had observed [REDACTED] outside around 8-9 PM about two weeks prior to the incident. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] was yelling for his mom so she went to get him and take him back to his residence. Mrs. [REDACTED] advised that Mrs. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (mother) did not know [REDACTED] was out. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that she had seen [REDACTED] out several times before during the day but this was the first incident of him being out at night. Mrs. [REDACTED] advised that she recommended child safety locks to Mrs. [REDACTED]

Sgt. [REDACTED] interviewed former [REDACTED] County Sheriff's office Deputy [REDACTED] on September 26, 2022. Mr. [REDACTED] advised that he had made a welfare check to the family home a few months prior to the reported incident. Mr. [REDACTED] advised that he bought the family groceries and gave them information for Pastor [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] Church of God to obtain assistance with food and other needs.

The Abuse Death investigation regarding Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was debriefed with Case Manager (CM) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and Team Leader (TL) [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Also present was Team Coordinator (TC) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] CPS Director (CPSD) [REDACTED], and Director of Critical Incident Support (DCIS) [REDACTED].

The CPS investigation was assigned on 9/26/22 concerning the death of ACV [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (2yo). [REDACTED] resided with his birth mother [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and birth father [REDACTED] [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] County. No other minors reside in the home. The mother has a 13yo child who has been voluntary full custody of the maternal grandmother since the age of 5 and resides with her. The father had no other children.

On 9/25/22 [REDACTED] was in the care and supervision of his father at the family home when was discovered by the neighbor in the neighbors pool at approximately 1:30pm. The neighbor called for help and ran to the familys home where he found the door ajar and the father asleep in the back bedroom. [REDACTED] was transported to [REDACTED] by EMS and was not breathing upon arrival. After life-saving measures were exhausted, [REDACTED] was pronounced deceased later that afternoon.

The parents work at McDonalds although in two different locations. The mother works at a McDonalds near approximately 5 minutes from the home. The father reported getting home from work at 12am on 9/25/22 after which he stayed up a couple hours then went to bed. The mother reported getting up at 5:45am to be at work at 6am, leaving [REDACTED] in the care of the father. The father reported he got up at 9:30am to put in a DVD for [REDACTED] to watch and then went back to bed. The father stated he would get up periodically to check on [REDACTED] but could not give definitive detail around this as far as number of times or the time of day. The father reported he was awoken at approximately 1:30pm by the neighbor in his home and alerting him to what happened. The parents stated [REDACTED] had learned how to unlock the door in the last few days and had gotten out of the home a few times. The mother stated this happened once while she watching [REDACTED] and washing dishes; however, she realized immediately and retrieved him. The other times occurred when the father was watching [REDACTED]. The parents stated they planned to get a safety lock for the door to address the problem, but had been unable to afford to do so yet.

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The home was cluttered and messy with animal feces and trash. The kitchen was clean compared to other parts of the home but there was very little food in the fridge or cabinets. The neighbors pool is within 100 yards of the family's home and has no fencing or gate around it. The pool was full of water and running with the ladder left in place, making it accessible to enter. The family has minor history with the Department which included a resource linkage case that closed in June 2022 for resources for food and furnishings. The parents reported [REDACTED] did not go to daycare and was healthy and up-to-date with his PCP. LE interviewed the neighbor. An autopsy was requested. LE investigation is still in the process of determining if any charges will be made.

**Next Steps:**

- CM will request current incident, birth, and PCP records. Records will be reviewed and uploaded to TFACTS.
- CM will request all interviews and information/evidence collected by LE within their investigation and review, summarize, and upload what is shared to TFACTS.
- CM will follow-up with the family regarding grief counseling and financial resources for burial.
- CM will document and upload autopsy into TFACTS once received.
- CM will complete Closing FAST prior to case closure.
- CM will present findings to the Child Protective Investigative Team (CPIT) for classification review.

Employee Assistance Program (EAP) information and supervisory support was discussed with involved staff.

Neighbors were interviewed by Det. ██████████ ██████████ It was stated by several neighbors that this was not the first time that the child had been out of the home without the parents knowing about it. None of the neighbors had called law enforcement when the child got out due to they knew who he belonged to.

The mother admitted to knowing that the child was getting out of the home without their knowledge.
