On 3/8/2023 at around 10:30 AM, Law Enforcement was called to the home. Law Enforcement arrived on scene and began to perform CPR on [REDACTED]. EMS arrived and transported [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] Hospital; it is unknown exactly when she arrived. On 3/8/2023 at an unknown time, [REDACTED] was pronounced deceased.

The cause of [REDACTED] death has not been stated. [REDACTED] reported that on 3/8/2023 at around 10:00 AM she had been feeding [REDACTED]. At first [REDACTED] stated that she does not remember if she was falling asleep and [REDACTED] gagged and quit breathing. Then [REDACTED] changed her story stating that she does not remember if she had fallen asleep and woke up to discover that [REDACTED] had quit breathing. It is unknown if [REDACTED] had any medical concerns.

[REDACTED] was not at the home during the incident as [REDACTED] cares for [REDACTED] while [REDACTED] goes to school. [REDACTED] and Mrs. [REDACTED] were at the home when the incident occurred; it is unknown what they have said about the incident. Marijuana was seen in one of the bedrooms; Law Enforcement also found a glass pipe in the bedroom. It is unknown who the marijuana belongs to, and it is unknown if the children have access to the drugs and paraphernalia. It was not questioned if [REDACTED] was impaired. The incident involving [REDACTED] occurred in a different bedroom. There is no more information regarding the drugs that were discovered in the home.

Some of the family is currently at the hospital and some is at the home; however, it is unclear which family member is where. It is unknown if DCS has been involved with the family in the past. The Police Report is [REDACTED]

It was reported that ██████ (3 months) lives with her mother, ██████ (15), her maternal uncle, ██████ (15), and her maternal grandmother, ██████ (34), in ██████ County. The family is staying at the home of a friend, ██████ (41), and ██████ children, ██████ (7) and ██████ (2). ██████ girlfriend, ██████ (15) [hereafter 'Mrs. ██████'] lives with her parents, Unknowns, in ██████ County. On 3/8/2023 at around 10:30 AM, Law Enforcement was called to the home. Law Enforcement arrived on scene and began to perform CPR on ██████ EMS arrived and transported ██████ to ██████ Hospital; it is unknown exactly when she arrived. On 3/8/2023 at an unknown time, ██████ was pronounced deceased. The cause of ██████ death has not been stated. ██████ reported that on 3/8/2023 at around 10:00 AM she had been feeding ██████. CM ██████ completed a walkthrough of the home in which the home was observed to have a lot of clutter throughout the room and floors CM ██████ provided the family with services and explained the case process. Grandmother was drug screened at the house and tested positive for Suboxone, but she did not have a prescription for it. Afterwards we completed an IPA for all three of ██████ kids to go to the step-grandfathers home along with his wife in ██████ County. A referral was called in for grandmothers drug concerns (Inv. ██████ Case Manager ██████ placed on the IPA for ██████ to complete an A&D assessment and

Parenting assessment, and to follow the recommendations once those assessments come back. CM received the records from [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and have been uploaded. CM reports that she has received the autopsy in which it was determined that the cause of death is acute methamphetamine intoxication. CM has uploaded the report into TFACTs. Grandmother was charged and arrested. CM [REDACTED] is closing investigation as allegation substantiated, perpetrator substantiated. There is enough evidence to support allegation of Drug Exposed Child and Abuse Death. The case was presented to CPIT on 11/29/23 and all members agreed to the classification. Closing FAST completed moderate nee/risk.

On March 8th, 2023, the Department of Childrens Services (DCS) received a referral for an allegation of Abuse Death regarding Alleged Child Victim (ACV), [REDACTED] (3 months). The Alleged Perpetrator (AP) was unknown at the time of the referral but was later identified as maternal grandmother, Mrs. [REDACTED]. This investigation was assigned to Child Protective Services Case Manager (CM) [REDACTED] by Lead Investigator (TL) [REDACTED]. This case was worked in conjunction with [REDACTED] County Sheriffs Office (CSO) Detectives, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] (3 months) lived at home with her birth mother, Miss [REDACTED]. Also, in the home resided her uncles, [REDACTED] (9) and [REDACTED] (14), her great uncles, Mr. [REDACTED] (25) and Mr. [REDACTED] (32), her maternal great grandmother, Ms. [REDACTED] and paternal grandfather, Mr. [REDACTED].

On March 8th, 2023, the [REDACTED] County Sheriffs Office was called to Mrs. [REDACTED] residence due to [REDACTED] being unresponsive. [REDACTED] was in the care of Mrs. [REDACTED] while [REDACTED] was at school. Law Enforcement arrived on scene and began to perform CPR on [REDACTED]. EMS arrived and transported [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] Hospital where she was pronounced deceased. Mrs. [REDACTED] was unable to provide a consistent story of what happened prior to [REDACTED] being found unresponsive.

Mrs. [REDACTED] friend and roommate, [REDACTED] and her children, [REDACTED] (16), [REDACTED] (8) and [REDACTED] (3) were at the home at the time. Marijuana and a glass pipe were found in one of the bedrooms, but it is unknown who it belonged to. The incident involving [REDACTED] occurred in a different bedroom. There is no more information if any children in the home had access to the marijuana or drug paraphernalia.

CM [REDACTED] interviewed Mrs. [REDACTED] on March 8th, 2023, at her residence. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that on the night of March 7th, 2023, [REDACTED] fell asleep between 4:30 and 5:00 p.m. while at Whataburger. Once they returned home, she fed [REDACTED] and burped her. [REDACTED] spit up but she had been doing that a lot lately. Mrs. [REDACTED] denied overfeeding [REDACTED] and explained [REDACTED] ate around 4-6 ounces. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] takes formula, but they also mix in cereal and the pediatrician approved this. CM [REDACTED] observed multiple cans of formula on top of the stove. The canister with the cereal had the label peeled off. CM [REDACTED] was informed by Mrs. [REDACTED] roommate, Ms. [REDACTED] that the label is off so that the family does not confuse the cereal with her formula. After [REDACTED] was fed and burped, Mrs. [REDACTED] put her on

the bed. She confirmed that [REDACTED] was on her back and that is the only way she would sleep. Mrs. [REDACTED] believes this may have been around 4am. [REDACTED] was dressed in a snap up onsie and she was not sleeping with any pillows or blankets. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported she was on a call around 7am on Facebook messenger. Mrs. [REDACTED] showed her call history on Facebook Messenger, and she was on a video call a little bit before 7am. [REDACTED] dozed off at some point after that and reports her phone falling. Mrs. [REDACTED] cannot confirm the exact time but at some point, that morning she got up to use the bathroom. That is when she noticed that [REDACTED] was cold. She picked up [REDACTED] and played with her cheeks to get her to wake up. When she did not, she ran to Ms. [REDACTED] room and asked her to help. She believes it was Ms. [REDACTED] who called 911 but she does not remember what time that happened. Ms. [REDACTED] son, [REDACTED] is the one who started to do CPR on [REDACTED] but [REDACTED] was not breathing. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] was transported to [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] denied that she or anyone else rode with [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] denied seeing any bruises or injuries on [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] denied that she noticed any fluids coming from [REDACTED] mouth or nose when she was found.

Mrs. [REDACTED] was asked about substance or prescription use. Mrs. [REDACTED] informed CM [REDACTED] that she takes Seroquel and is prescribed an antidepressant, Amitriptyline but she doesn't take it. CM [REDACTED] observed the prescription bottle, and it was last filled on November 13th, 2022 and there were no refills available until doctor authorizes. CM [REDACTED] requested Mrs. [REDACTED] completed a drug screen. Mrs. [REDACTED] provided a few excuses not to take one such as not being able to go and being too cold. Mrs. [REDACTED] was provided with a glass of water. Mrs. [REDACTED] signed the form consenting to a drug screen but for approximately 45 minutes she continued to be difficult about completing it. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that she is not comfortable taking the screen with someone watching. Mrs. [REDACTED] was informed multiple times that it is procedure for DCS to observe the test being taken to ensure it is valid. Mrs. [REDACTED] refused at first but later agreed as long as Mrs. [REDACTED] stands in the door and CM [REDACTED] remains in front of Mrs. [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] completed the urine screen that CM [REDACTED] observed through the door that was cracked open. CM [REDACTED] observed the screen and Mrs. [REDACTED] was positive for Buprenorphine in which she was unable to provide a valid prescription for. Mrs. [REDACTED] denied that has ever taken Suboxone or Subutex and is unsure why her test would show positive for that. Mrs. [REDACTED] had previously stated to the detectives that she did take Adderall (unprescribed) around a week ago. She did not disclose who provided her with this. She also had used methamphetamine in the past but that was around a year and a half ago.

CM [REDACTED] spoke with the homeowner, Ms. [REDACTED] on March 8th, 2023. CM [REDACTED] asked Ms. [REDACTED] to walk her through what happened in the morning. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that this morning she woke up around 10:42 a.m. By 10:45 a.m, Mrs. [REDACTED] was running towards Ms. [REDACTED] room holding [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] was frantic and was asking Ms. [REDACTED] to tell her what was wrong with [REDACTED]. They laid [REDACTED] on Ms. [REDACTED] bed, and her lips were visibly blue. Ms. [REDACTED] son, [REDACTED] was present, and he put [REDACTED] on the floor and started CPR. Ms. [REDACTED] called the police by 10:59a.m. The police responded fast, and [REDACTED] carried [REDACTED] out to them. The rest of the household members were sitting outside while the police started working on [REDACTED]. They could not find a pulse and she was then transported to the medical center. CM [REDACTED] inquired on if Ms. [REDACTED] observed anything on [REDACTED] such as bruises or injuries. Ms. [REDACTED] denied this and denied observing any fluids from her mouth or nose. The last time [REDACTED] was seen alive had to be around 3:00am when she had urinated on Ms. [REDACTED] stuff. Ms. [REDACTED] denied any concerns of [REDACTED] being in the care of Ms. [REDACTED]. Ms. [REDACTED] admitted that she uses marijuana but denied any knowledge of Mrs. [REDACTED] using substances.

On March 9th, 2023, an autopsy was completed by [REDACTED], M.D., J.D., Ph.D at the Office of the Medical Examiner located in [REDACTED] TN. The pathological diagnoses included small abrasions, Pulmonary congestion, and edema, consistent with respiratory bronchiolitis under microscopic examination and bilateral mucoid otitis. There was no evidence of congenital anomaly or internal trauma. The postmortem toxicologic studies indicate the presence of methamphetamine in the blood.

Cause of Death: Acute methamphetamine intoxication

On November 29th, 2023, CM [REDACTED] presented this case to the [REDACTED] County Child Protective Investigative Team (CPIT). Those in attendance were TL [REDACTED] TL [REDACTED] TC [REDACTED] Detective [REDACTED] ADA [REDACTED] [REDACTED] DA [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] County CAC staff. The team agreed that there is enough evidence that supports the substantiation of the Abuse Death and Drug Exposed Child.

Per DCS Policy Work Aid 1 Section E:
 Child Death is defined as:

- a) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect.
- b) Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report.
- c) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect resulting from the parent or caretakers failure to stop another persons direct action that resulted in the death of the child. Child deaths are always treated as severe abuse.

The Abuse Death investigation regarding Alleged Child Victim (ACV) ██████████ was debriefed with Case Manager (CM) ██████████ and Team Leader (TL) ██████████. Also present was Team Coordinator (TC) ██████████ and CPS Director (CPSD) ██████████.

The CPS investigation was assigned on 3/9/23 concerning the death of ACV ██████████ (3mo). The cause of death wasn't determined at the time the referral was called in to DCS. ██████████ the grandmother to ██████████ was the person who was caring for the baby when 911 was called for the child. ██████████ also goes by ██████████. Grandmother said she had fed ██████████ around 10 AM. She first reported she could not remember if she was drifting to sleep or not, then she changed her story saying she could not remember if ██████████ as gagging or quit breathing, then she changed her story again saying she could not remember if she fallen asleep and woke up to ██████████ not breathing. However, she reported she told the paramedics that she woke up to the child choking. The baby's birth mother is a minor who is 15 years old and was at school during the time of the incident. Grandmother (██████████) is the caretaker during the day while mom is at school. ██████████ has two other kids who are in the home with her, a 14-year-old, and a 9-year-old. They are living with a friend of the mothers who also has their family in the same home. There were concerns of several drug paraphernalia in some of the bedrooms. ██████████ added the Minor Mom lives with her father in ██████████ and the baby lives with her when she is not at school.

Case Manager has interviewed birth mom (██████████) and all the adults in the ██████████ home as well the paternal grandfather. Then Case Manager ██████████ traveled to the home where the baby was found and spoke to ██████████ the grandmother and her two kids in the home as well as the homeowner and her children as well. ██████████ asked about the grandmothers story. ██████████ stated the grandmother told a different version of her story to each party: the police/detective, to Case Manager, and to EMS. Grandmother was drug screened at the house and tested positive for Suboxone, but she did not have a prescription for it. Afterwards we completed an IPA for all three of ██████████ kids to go to the step-grandfathers home along with his wife in ██████████ County. A referral was called in for grandmothers drug concerns (Inv. ██████████). Case Manager ██████████ placed on the IPA for ██████████ to complete an A&D assessment and Parenting assessment, and to follow the recommendations once those assessments come back. Team Coordinator ██████████ wanted to know why the 3 kids father could not be considered as a placement for his kids. ██████████ explained the

other adults in the fathers home would not agree to do a drug screen saying some of them would fail and they could not be moved out of the home to allow the kids to be placed there. The kids are still attending school in [REDACTED] until other arrangements are determined.

[REDACTED] asked about the babys father. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] did say the father was in the babys life, she had shown the Case Manager a recent photo of the father and baby together. Continue to offer the family grief counseling, even though [REDACTED] doesnt want Dept. of Childrens Services to contact her daughter. Collect a copy of the completed autopsy and prepare to conference with CPIT once the report has been received. All documents pertaining to the case needs to be uploaded in TFACTS.

[REDACTED] asked for everyone to be careful in documenting all interactions with the family because there is a possibility we will substantiate the grandmother. The groups concerns were the following:

- The home was cluttered.
- The grandmother and birth mother were over feeding the child 9 oz, instead of 4-6 oz, which the PCP recommended for a 3-month-old.
- They were also adding cereal in the bottle, which is a concern if the PCP states it was too early to introduce that substance to the childs diet.
- Grandmother was under the influence of drugs (DEC)
- Case Manager asked about a pack-n-play, grandmother said the detectives took the pack-n-play and when the Case Manager asked the detectives about it, they stated they didnt have the pack-n-play, in which grandmothers story changed again.
- The grandmothers past history of drug use and why she is taking unprescribed medication.
- Lastly, grandmothers CPS history.

Employee Assistance Program (EAP) information and supervisory support was discussed with involved staff.

Mrs. [REDACTED] informed CM [REDACTED] and TL [REDACTED] that she is unable to do that since she doesn't have to go, and she reported being too cold. Mrs. [REDACTED] was provided with a glass of water. Mrs. [REDACTED] signed the form consenting to a drug screen but for approximately 45 minutes she continued to be difficult about completing it. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that she is not comfortable taking the screen with someone watching. Mrs. [REDACTED] was informed multiple times that it is procedure for DCS to observe the test being taken to ensure it is valid. Mrs. [REDACTED] refused at first but later agreed as long as Mrs. [REDACTED] stands in the door and CM [REDACTED] remains in front of Mrs. [REDACTED] Mrs. [REDACTED] completed the urine screen that CM [REDACTED] observed through the door that was cracked open. CM [REDACTED] observed the screen and Mrs. [REDACTED] was positive for Buprenorphine in which she was unable to provide a valid prescription for. Mrs. [REDACTED] denied that has ever taken Suboxone or Subutex and is unsure why her test would show positive for that. Mrs. [REDACTED] had previously stated to the detectives that she did take Adderall (unprescribed) around a week ago. She did not disclose who provided her with this. She also had used methamphetamine in the past but that was around a year and a half ago.

CM [REDACTED] explained to Mrs. [REDACTED] that due to the positive result, the department is requesting that an immediate protection agreement is put in place. Mrs. [REDACTED] became very upset and reported she did not understand why the department would do this right after she lost a grandchild. The immediate protection agreement process was explained to Mrs. [REDACTED] and CM [REDACTED] requested that Mrs. [REDACTED] identify friends and family that she believes would be suitable to care for the children. Mrs. [REDACTED] at first identified her mother's residence. CM [REDACTED] called Ms. [REDACTED] who confirmed that there is substance use in the home from at least her eldest son. She believes he may only be using marijuana. Mrs. [REDACTED] was informed that Ms. [REDACTED] residence would not be an option. TL [REDACTED] contacted Mr. [REDACTED] and explained the immediate protection agreement. Mr. [REDACTED] inquired on if the children could remain with him if he gets a hotel. Mr. [REDACTED] admitted that this would only be a few days as he cannot financially afford to stay in a hotel. Mr. [REDACTED] does not have a residence and is currently staying with Ms. [REDACTED] Mr. [REDACTED] could not provide a plan for long term housing due to the financial restrictions. Ms. [REDACTED] asked if she leaves the residence, can Ms. [REDACTED] be a placement option. TL [REDACTED] explained to Ms. [REDACTED] the process in which everyone in the home would have to be able to pass a background check and a drug screen. Ms. [REDACTED] then reported that Mr. [REDACTED] children wouldn't be able to stay there then because she knows

she will fail for marijuana. Her two adult children walked away, and no information was provided on what they may or may not test for if drug screened.

The back part of the home was observed to have a lot of clutter throughout the room and floors. No structural concerns or immediate safety hazards were observed. Mrs. [REDACTED] informed CM [REDACTED] that she takes Seroquel and is prescribed an antidepressant, Amitriptyline but she doesn't take it. CM [REDACTED] observed the prescription bottle and it was last filled on November 13th, 2022 and there were no refills available until doctor authorizes. CM [REDACTED] requested Mrs. [REDACTED] completed a drug screen. Mrs. [REDACTED] provided a few excuses not to take one such as not being able to go and being too cold. Mrs. [REDACTED] was provided with a glass of water. Mrs. [REDACTED] signed the form consenting to a drug screen but for approximately 45 minutes she continued to be difficult about completing it. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that she is not comfortable taking the screen with someone watching. Mrs. [REDACTED] was informed multiple times that it is procedure for DCS to observe the test being taken to ensure it is valid. Mrs. [REDACTED] refused at first but later agreed as long as Mrs. [REDACTED] stands in the door and CM [REDACTED] remains in front of Mrs. [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] completed the urine screen that CM [REDACTED] observed through the door that was cracked open. CM [REDACTED] observed the screen and Mrs. [REDACTED] was positive for Buprenorphine in which she was unable to provide a valid prescription for. Mrs. [REDACTED] denied that has ever taken Suboxone or Subutex and is unsure why her test would show positive for that.

Drug exposed child:

This allegation pertains to a person, under the age of 18 who: Has been exposed to or is at risk of exposure to a drug or chemical substance (including but not limited to alcohol, cannabis, hallucinogens, stimulants, sedatives, narcotics, methamphetamine, heroin, inhalants) that could adversely affect the child's physical, mental or emotional functioning; or Has a parent/caregiver that uses drugs or chemical substances that impacts or is at risk of impacting their ability to adequately care for the child. The manufacturing of methamphetamine where children are present or in close proximity will always be considered severe abuse.

Child Death:

Child death is defined as:

- a) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect.
- b) Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report.
- c) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect resulting from the parent or legal custodian/caretaker failure to stop another person's direct action that resulted in the death of the child. Child deaths are always treated as severe abuse.

2. A near death, per Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA) 37-5-107(c)(4) is defined as a serious or critical medical condition resulting from abuse, neglect or child sexual abuse, as reported by a physician who has examined the child subsequent to the abuse or neglect. When an initial referral or a referral on an open case contains information that suggests the child is in a serious or critical medical condition as a result of the allegation(s) or has been determined to meet the criteria for an allegation of near death as defined above, the Child Abuse Hotline selects Preliminary Near Death (PND) Indicator in TFACTS on the participants tab on a new intake or the investigative persons tab on an active case. The information does not have to come from a physician. Preliminary near deaths are always treated as severe child abuse.

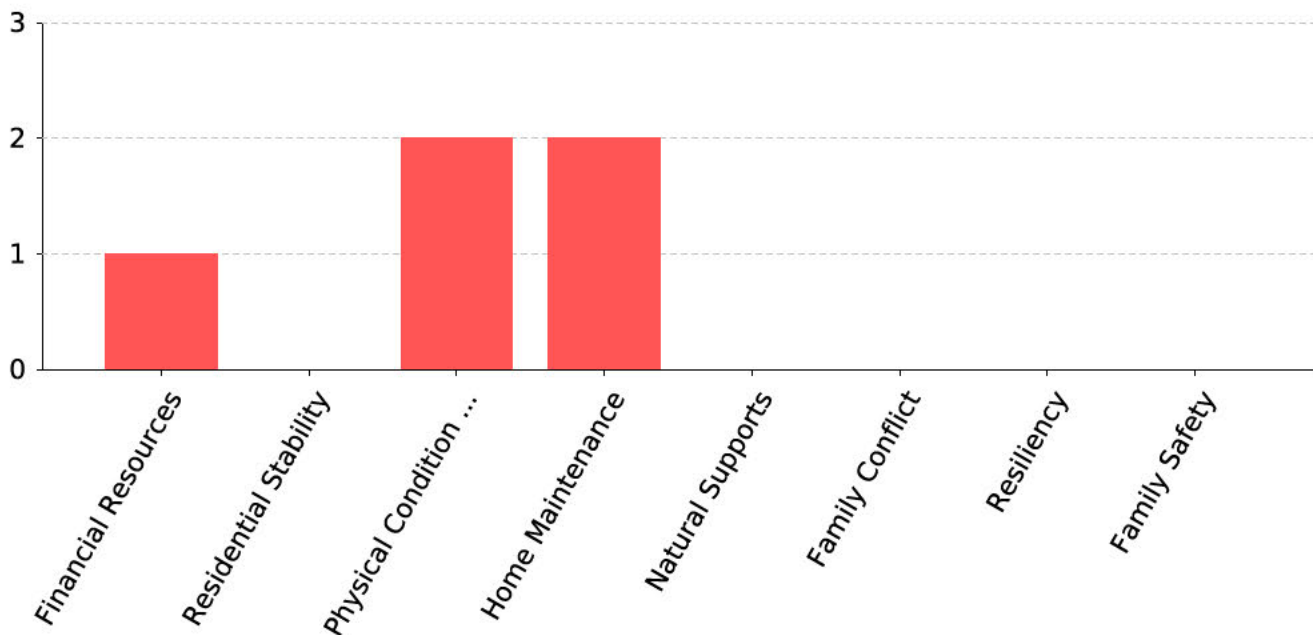

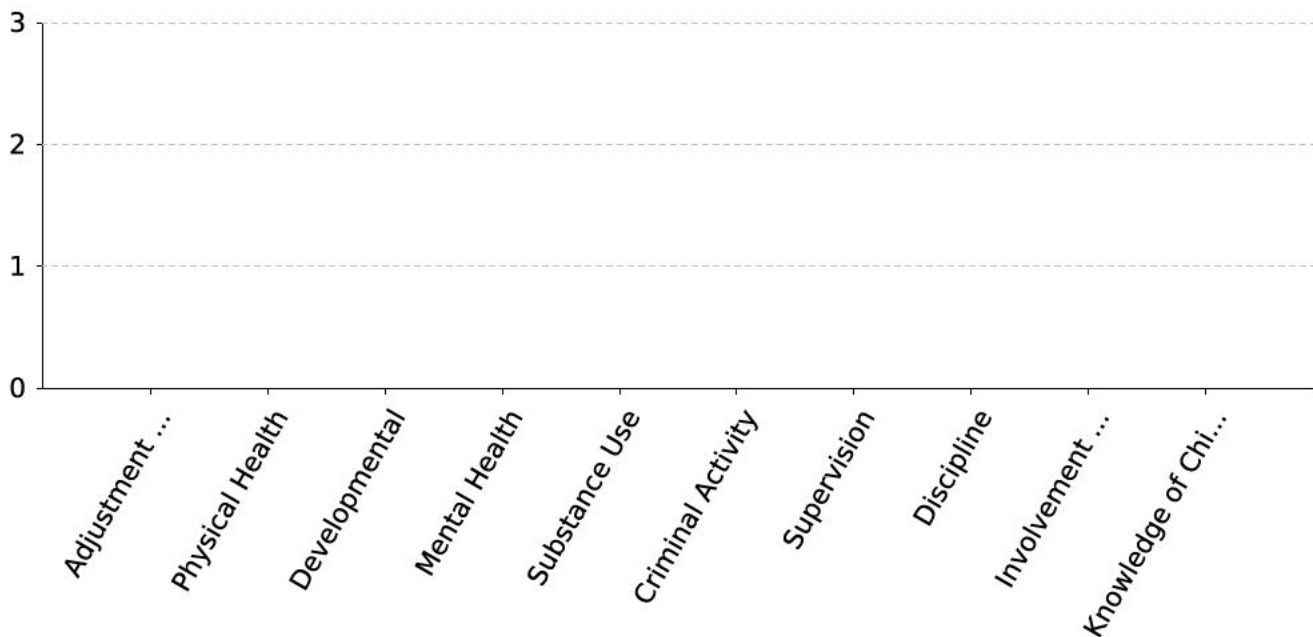

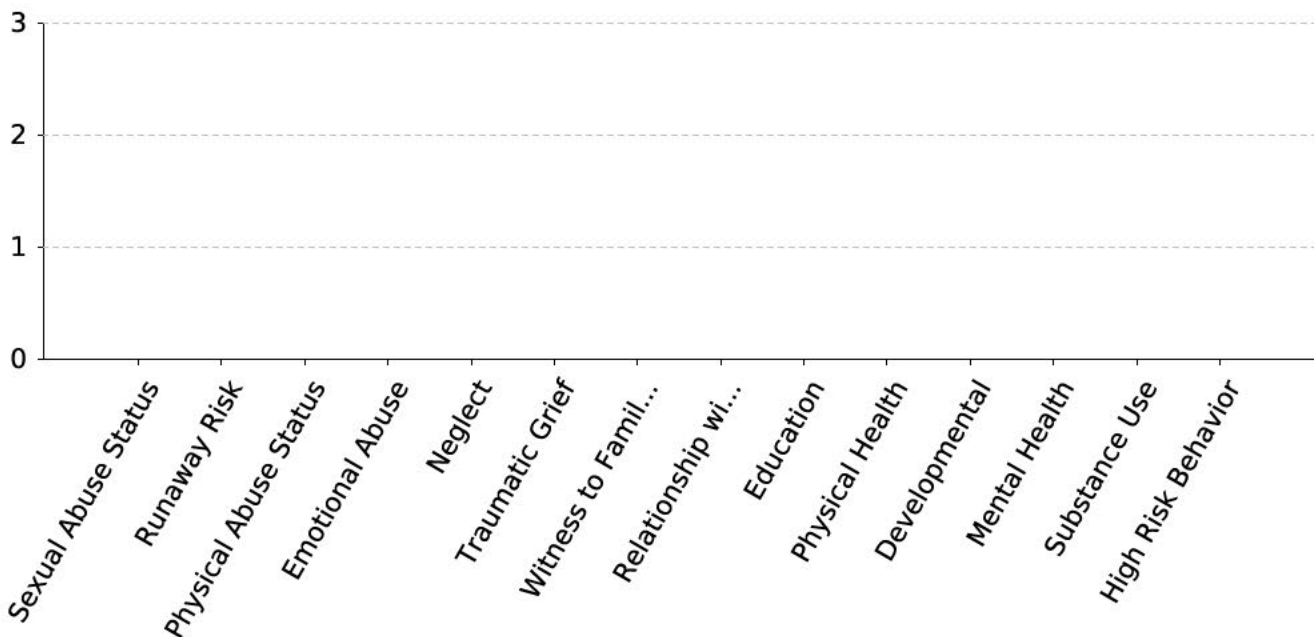
