On June 16, 2023, the Department of Childrens Services (DCS) received a referral for the allegation of Abuse Death regarding Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (4). The Alleged Perpetrator (AP) was Birth Mother, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. This investigation was assigned to Lead Investigator (LI) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] by Team Coordinator (TC) [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. This case was worked in conjunction with The [REDACTED] Police Department ([REDACTED] PD).

[REDACTED] [REDACTED] (4) lived at home with her birth mother, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] her moms paramour, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and her sibling, [REDACTED] [REDACTED].

On June 16, 2023, a report was received regarding [REDACTED] [REDACTED] being missing since June 15, 2023. Remains were found by Law Enforcement and other agencies. It is believed the remains belong to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] has a sister named [REDACTED] [REDACTED] but her whereabouts were unknown. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and her paramour, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] are being charged in connection to [REDACTED] death.

On June 15, 2023, the police viewed footage from a nearby homes ring camera. They saw an image of a person. They believed it could have been [REDACTED] but they are not sure. The 8-year-old, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] told investigators that she never saw [REDACTED] last night, she just knew she was in the room. The other 4-year-old child, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] didnt report anything. Its no longer considered a missing child investigation. The police upgraded it to an endangered child search. Ms. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and other family members were taken to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] for questioning.

Ms. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was interviewed, while she was sitting in the police car. Ms. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that she last saw [REDACTED] [REDACTED] around midnight. She stated that she and her boyfriend, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] were asleep on the couch. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was in the room with her sister, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] are the niece and nephew of Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and they were just visiting the home. She said they did not know [REDACTED] [REDACTED] had left the house. Ms. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] noticed that [REDACTED] [REDACTED] had gotten the cake out of the refrigerator. This is not the first time [REDACTED] [REDACTED] has exited the house, but this is the first time that she has wandered off.

[REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was in the room by herself because she was in trouble. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] pooped on herself.

[REDACTED] must sleep in the room by herself because she pees and poops on herself. She said she did not see her go out of the door, but she knows she did. [REDACTED] made her, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stay in the room. [REDACTED] overheard her Aunt [REDACTED] saying that a boy in [REDACTED] had [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] went to the [REDACTED] Child Advocacy Center for a forensic interview. This case was initially assigned to the "Missing Persons Bureau." [REDACTED] said she heard someone say that [REDACTED] "sneaked out the door and that she was gone." The night before, she assisted [REDACTED] with her bath, stating [REDACTED] dried herself off and put her own clothes back on. [REDACTED] said her sister did not sleep in the same bedroom as she did. Prior to [REDACTED] taking a bath, her sister had an accident and pooped herself. That is why she had to take a bath. [REDACTED] often whipped [REDACTED] for pooping and urinating on herself, stating she saw a bruise on her sister's body. NOTE: Child pointed to an area near the armpit. When asked if her mom spanked her sister, [REDACTED] hesitated and replied, "I don't know." Her mom and [REDACTED] were asleep in the living room, on the couch. [REDACTED] said her sister often urinates herself, so they try not to give her a lot to drink. [REDACTED] heard her aunt, Arnesha, say that someone made a post from the [REDACTED] area, saying they had her little sister and was feeding her. [REDACTED] dressed herself, and she had on a pink shirt with hearts and blue pants with hearts. [REDACTED] never saw her sister after she took a bath that night.

[REDACTED] niece to alleged perpetrator [REDACTED] came to the [REDACTED] Child Advocacy Center for a forensic interview. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] was missing. According to [REDACTED] when she got to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] apartment, [REDACTED] was playing on the phone, and she was told [REDACTED] was in the tub. [REDACTED] did not see or hear [REDACTED] that night. Before falling asleep, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were eating snacks in [REDACTED] room, on the bunk beds. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were on the top bunk, and [REDACTED] was on the bottom. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was sleeping in [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] room. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were in the living room. That night, [REDACTED] heard the door of the home closing. The next morning when she woke up, she was in shock because [REDACTED] was missing. [REDACTED] cannot open the door because she is only 4 years old, and the door is hard to open. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] said robbers came and got [REDACTED]

On March 28, 2024, the Autopsy report was received. The autopsy was completed on [REDACTED] [REDACTED] on June 16, 2023, by the [REDACTED] Tennessee Regional Forensic Center, [REDACTED] TN. Autopsy findings include advanced decomposition, acute and remote fractures to the left 5th rib, acute and remote fractures to the left 7th through 12th ribs, and acute and remote fractures of the right 9th through 12th ribs. Death was caused by blunt trauma of the torso. Reports of the death scene investigation, circumstances surrounding and leading up to the death, and autopsy findings indicate the manner of death to be homicide.

On July 24, 2024, Sergeant [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] Police Departments Homicide Bureau, stated [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were both indicted on Aggravated Child Abuse, First Degree Murder, Aggravated Child Neglect, Abuse of a Corpse, Tampering with Evidence, and False Reports.

On July 25, 2024, the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] case was presented to the [REDACTED] County Child Protective Investigative Team (CPIT). The CPIT Meeting was held via Zoom Video Conference.

The Alleged Child Victim is [REDACTED] [REDACTED] The Alleged Perpetrators are Birth Mother, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] The Allegation is Abuse Death.

The CPIT Team consisted of Assistant District Attorney [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Department of Children's Services Workers, [REDACTED] Child Advocacy Center Staff, and Law Enforcement.

The Abuse Death investigation regarding Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] was debriefed with the following staff: Case Managers (CM) [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Team Leaders (TL) [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Team Coordinators (TC) [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], CPS Director (CPSD) [REDACTED], and Director of Critical Incident Support (DCIS) [REDACTED].

The CPS investigation was assigned on 6/16/23 concerning the death of ACV [REDACTED] (4yo). It was reported [REDACTED] resided with her birth mother [REDACTED] sibling [REDACTED] (5yo), and the mothers boyfriend [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] County.

The Department received a prior referral on 6/15/23 in which it was the mother had woken early that morning and noted the front door of the home was open, noted [REDACTED] was missing and contacted police. At that time the mother reported she last observed [REDACTED] in the home when she put [REDACTED] to bed in a room with the other children around 11:45pm. Upon LE response to the home during this investigation, LE located [REDACTED] remains in close proximity to the home in a garbage bin. The mother then admitted to falsifying her previous statement and said her boyfriend physically attacked [REDACTED] multiple times weeks prior, after which the last time [REDACTED] became unresponsive and never regained consciousness after the boyfriend attempted to revive her. The mother reported [REDACTED] body was placed in several garbage bags and maintained in the home until recently placed in the outside bin that day. The boyfriend denied any knowledge of [REDACTED] condition stating he last saw her on 6/11/23; however, due to the advanced stage of decomposition authorities reported this was not possible. The mother and boyfriend were arrested.

The 5yo sibling along with the boyfriends niece [REDACTED] and nephew [REDACTED] (4yo) who had stayed the night in the home, were all forensically interviewed. The 5yo sibling reported the boyfriend would whoop [REDACTED] when she had bathroom accidents and reported never seeing her again after she had accident and bath that night. She reported no abuse toward herself, and no observable marks or injuries were noted. The 8yo niece reported she had never seen [REDACTED] that night and was told she was in the tub and later sleeping in the mothers room. The 4yo nephews interview was limited and yielded no evidentiary information due to communication limitations.
