On 6/16/2023, [REDACTED] Police responded to a home at [REDACTED], [REDACTED] TN, regarding an unresponsive infant. [REDACTED] was found unresponsive and is still not responsive at this time. She will be airlifted to the hospital. [REDACTED] was found with visible injuries. [REDACTED] has marks and bruises of different sizes on the back side of his legs and buttocks. No further details are known about the injuries, but investigators have pictures. It is unknown how the injuries and bruises were caused. Law enforcement states that it appears the children were victims of child abuse, but this is still under investigation. It is unknown if there will be any arrests made at this time. [REDACTED] is currently with the [REDACTED] Police. [REDACTED] was not at the home when the incident occurred, as the children were in the care of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated to officers that she has seen visible injuries on [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] other times after they were in the care of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] (unknown dates). It is unknown why [REDACTED] still allowed the children to go back to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] home. [REDACTED] stated that she called [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] when she got off today and they stated that the children were "passed out asleep". When [REDACTED] called back this morning (6/16/2023), [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated that they needed to call 911 because one of the children was unresponsive.

On June 16, 2023, the Department of Children's Services (DCS) received a referral for an allegation of Abuse Death regarding Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] (Date of Birth [REDACTED]; 2 years). The Alleged Perpetrators (AP) were identified as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Additional allegations involved in the case were as follows: Physical Abuse regarding ACV [REDACTED] against AP [REDACTED] Lack of Supervision regarding ACV [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] against AP [REDACTED] Lack of Supervision regarding ACV [REDACTED] against AP [REDACTED] regarding ACV [REDACTED]. This investigation was assigned to Child Protective Service Case Manager (CM) [REDACTED] by Team Leader (TL) [REDACTED]. CM [REDACTED] assisted with the investigation. This case was worked in conjunction with [REDACTED] Police Department Investigator [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] resided with his mother, [REDACTED] and sibling, [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] TN at the time of her death. At the time of the referral, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were in the home of their babysitter, [REDACTED]. Also in Mrs. [REDACTED] home were [REDACTED] (husband) and their children [REDACTED] (age 1) and [REDACTED] (age 5).

On June 16, 2023, [REDACTED] was found to be unresponsive by her babysitter, [REDACTED] in her home located at [REDACTED] Tennessee. [REDACTED] Police Department responded to the address where [REDACTED] was still not responsive. [REDACTED] was taken to [REDACTED] Hospital where she was then airlift to [REDACTED] Children's Hospital at [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] Tennessee. Based off the medical report by [REDACTED] LMSW, at [REDACTED] Medical Center, [REDACTED] was presented to the emergency department by Emergency Medical Services (EMS) with Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) in progress. [REDACTED] was presented with numerous visible bodily injuries and bruises, consistent with inflicted trauma and abusive head trauma. [REDACTED] was pronounced deceased at [REDACTED] Children's Hospital on June 16, 2023, at 4:08pm.

On June 16, 2023, CM [REDACTED] observed interview by Investigator [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] mother of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] reported she works at the [REDACTED] is [REDACTED] as a stripper. She works 4 days a week. She reported she dropped the children off at the babysitters, [REDACTED] residence on Tuesday, June 13, 2023. She reported she checked on the children every morning and Mrs. [REDACTED] always advised her both

children were fine. On Thursday, June 15, 2023 the maternal grandmother, Mrs. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] facetime'd both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] did mention to [REDACTED] that there were visible bruises that were observed during facetime. [REDACTED] reported she always asked Mrs. [REDACTED] about the bruises, and she was always able to provide a reason for the bruising, and she had no indication to be concerned. Ms. [REDACTED] reported she has observed Mrs. [REDACTED] husband, Mr. [REDACTED] drunk when she dropped the children off at the residence, but Mr. [REDACTED] was not the one babysitting.

Ms. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] is clumsy and felt that the bruising he was getting was from him falling all the time.

Mrs. [REDACTED] reported she has only known Mrs. [REDACTED] for 3 months and she hired her to babysit the children based on a recommendation from her friend as she saw a post on Facebook. Ms. [REDACTED] had posted an ad to become a babysitter.

On June 16, 2023, CM [REDACTED] observed interview by Investigator [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that last night was the first night both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] slept on their cots. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported she does spank [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] sits them in time out, or send them to bed for discipline.

On June 16, 2023, CM [REDACTED] observed interview by Investigator [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] Mr. [REDACTED] reported on Wednesday night he cannot remember anything because he drank so much. Mr. [REDACTED] reported he started drinking approximately one year ago. Mr. [REDACTED] first reported he could not remember, but then reported everyone went to bed around 11PM. Mr. [REDACTED] reported that his daughter, [REDACTED] woke up crying, so he went into the bedroom and consoled her. Mr. [REDACTED] went back and laid back down when he heard [REDACTED] had started crying. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he went into the bedroom and grabbed [REDACTED] by her face and told her to hush and threw her back onto her cot. Mr. [REDACTED] reported part of her body hit the cot and the other part hit the concrete floor. Mr. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] moaned about three times and her eyes were observed opened. Mr. [REDACTED] reported he checked the back of [REDACTED] head, and her head was just fine. Mr. [REDACTED] reported he went back to bed. Mr. [REDACTED] was arrested and charged with 1st Degree Murder and 2 counts aggravated child abuse/neglect.

On June 16, 2023, CM [REDACTED] and Assistant District Attorney [REDACTED] spoke with Dr. [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] Hospital. It has been determined [REDACTED] has abusive head trauma and a subdural brain swollen.

On June 17, 2023 an autopsy was completed on ACV [REDACTED] by Dr. [REDACTED], M.D., Office of the Medical Examiner, Center for Forensic Medicine, [REDACTED] TN. The cause of death was identified as Blunt Force Injuries. The manner of death was identified as Homicide. The circumstances of death were identified as Assaulted by others.

On February 23, 2024, CM [REDACTED] presented this case to the [REDACTED] County Child Protective Investigative Team (CPIT). Those in attendance were TL [REDACTED] Investigator [REDACTED] Assistant District Attorney [REDACTED] Child Advocacy Center members [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] County Youth Services Officer [REDACTED]. The team agreed that there is a preponderance of evidence that supports the allegation of the Abuse Death. The case was classified as allegation substantiated, perpetrator substantiated against AP [REDACTED] regarding ACV [REDACTED]. The team agreed that there is not preponderance of evidence that supports the allegation of Abuse Death against AP [REDACTED].

On June 16, 2023, the Department of Children's Services completed an Immediate Protection Agreement and filed a petition regarding ACV [REDACTED] placing him with his Maternal Grandparents [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. On June 26, 2023, the court ruled that [REDACTED] would return to his mother, [REDACTED] and the petition filed by DCS would be dismissed.

On June 16, 2023, the Department of Children's Services also addressed the safety and well-being of ACVs [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] children of AP [REDACTED] and AP [REDACTED]. The children were placed in the custody of their Paternal Grandparents [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. On August 16, 2023, the court granted a trial home visit placing the children back with [REDACTED]. The court also ordered that the children could have supervised phone calls with their father, [REDACTED].

Chapter 14 - Child Protective Services Work Aid 1 defines the following criteria for the allegations:  
 Child death:

1. Child Death: Child death is defined as:

a) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect.

b) Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report. c) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect resulting from the parent or legal custodian/caretaker failure to stop another persons direct action that resulted in the death of the child. Child deaths are always treated as severe abuse.

2. A near death, per Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA) 37-5-107(c)(4) is defined as a serious or critical medical condition resulting from abuse, neglect, or child sexual abuse, as reported by a physician who has examined the child subsequent to the abuse or neglect. When an initial referral or a referral on an open case contains information that suggests the child is in a serious or critical medical condition as a result of the allegation(s) or has been determined to meet the criteria for an allegation of near death as defined above, the Child Abuse Hotline selects Preliminary Near Death (PND) Indicator in TFACTS on the participants tab on a new intake or the investigative persons tab on an active case. The information does not have to come from a physician. Preliminary near deaths are always treated as severe child abuse.

There is preponderance of the evidence to support the allegation of Abuse Death regarding AP [REDACTED] against ACV [REDACTED]. This case will be closed and classified as Allegation Substantiated, Perpetrator Substantiated regarding ACV [REDACTED].

There is preponderance of evidence to support the Allegation of Physical Abuse regarding AP [REDACTED] against ACV [REDACTED]. The case is closed and classified as Allegation Substantiated, Perpetrator Substantiated ACV [REDACTED] against AP [REDACTED].

The CPS investigation was assigned on 6/18/23 concerning the death of ACV [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (2yo) and PND allegations of Physical Abuse and Lack of Supervision concerning twin sibling [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (2yo). It was reported [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] resided with their birth mother [REDACTED] [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] County. The birth father [name unknown] has reportedly been incarcerated and never been involved or contacted the children. The incident occurred at the home of the babysitter [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and her paramour [REDACTED] [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] County. The babysitters have two children, ages 4yo and 2yo.

On 6/16/23 911 was called from the babysitters home regarding and unresponsive infant, ACV [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was reportedly found unresponsive by the babysitter. External injuries were noted including what appeared to be facial/head swelling and bruising.
