[REDACTED] has another child, [REDACTED] (last name unknown, est. age 3), who also resides in the home. The name of the father of the children is unknown, and he resides at a separate location in [REDACTED] County. It is believed [REDACTED] has custody of the children, but this is not certain. It is reported the children normally reside with [REDACTED] but they were dropped off with their father yesterday due to [REDACTED] starting a new job.

On October 3, 2023, [REDACTED] was found unresponsive at the home of his father. The father called 911 after finding [REDACTED] unresponsive at the home. The exact time [REDACTED] was found unresponsive is unknown. It is unknown where in the home [REDACTED] was found unresponsive. [REDACTED] was reportedly last seen awake by his father at around 10:00p.m. on October 2, 2023. [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] Medical Center via ambulance at around 3:00a.m. on October 3, 2023. [REDACTED] arrived at the hospital with CPR in progress and CPR was continued for about 9 minutes. [REDACTED] was pronounced deceased at around 3:11a.m. on October 3, 2023. [REDACTED] already has some rigor mortis so it is believed he has been deceased for at least a few hours. [REDACTED] does not have any overt signs of injury on his body. It is unknown if [REDACTED] had any medical conditions or concerns prior to his death.

[REDACTED] cause of death is unknown at this time. Law Enforcement and EMS reported there are concerns of abuse or neglect as the cause of death. There is no information known about what type of abuse or neglect is suspected as the cause of death or why abuse or neglect is suspected. Law Enforcement expressed concerns about criminal activity when EMS and Law Enforcement arrived at the father's home. The type of criminal activity that was suspected is unknown. The father was not allowed to go to the emergency room when [REDACTED] was taken to the hospital. It is believed the father is currently being questioned about the incident by Law Enforcement.

[REDACTED] is currently at the hospital, but it is unknown how long she will remain at the hospital. [REDACTED] has been very distraught and has not been able to provide much information. [REDACTED] was not present when [REDACTED] was found unresponsive. It is believed Law Enforcement tracked [REDACTED] down. [REDACTED] is believed to be in the care of his maternal grandmother (unknown). It is believed [REDACTED] will be brought to the hospital to see [REDACTED] because [REDACTED] wanted to see him. It is unknown if there are any concerns about [REDACTED] at this time, but [REDACTED] was at the father's home at the time [REDACTED] was found unresponsive. [REDACTED] body is still at the emergency room, but he will be transported to an unknown location. The medical examiner just left the emergency room and has accepted the case.

There is no information available about the living conditions at [REDACTED] home or at the father's home. It is unknown if there are any concerns regarding domestic violence, substance abuse, or mental health issues at either [REDACTED] home or the father's home. Law Enforcement is investigating the case at this time. The detective involved in the case with [REDACTED] Police Department [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] County is [REDACTED].

CM [REDACTED] interviewed the mother regarding the incident. Mother reported that Mr. [REDACTED] is the birth father of deceased ACV. Mr. [REDACTED] has infrequent contact with the child. The mother just started a new job and Mr. [REDACTED] agreed to care for the children while she gets settled in a routine with her new schedule. The mother dropped both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] off at Mr. [REDACTED] home, the morning of 10/2/2023. Mother could not recall the actual time she dropped the children off. She did not enter the home, but dropped the children off at the door. She saw the children enter and both were happy and running around the living room, from what she could see from the front door. She then left the home. There were no concerns noted at this time. Grief services were offered and provided to the mother. CM [REDACTED] contacted assigned Youth Services Detective [REDACTED] [REDACTED] for more information. Det. [REDACTED] reported that he responded to the father's home and the home was clean and tidy. There were no concerns regarding the physical home environment. The father just moved into the apartment so the children did not have sleeping arrangements set up. The children fell asleep on the couch. The couch was described as a "big couch". The paternal aunt observed both children asleep at approximately 11 p.m. on 10/2/23. [REDACTED] (deceased) was observed sleeping on his side. At approximately 2:40 a.m., the father went to check on the children and observed [REDACTED] body to be cold, wet, stiff, and his tongue was sticking out of his mouth. The child was wearing shorts and underwear. He was not covered by a blanket. The medical examiner suspects that the child may have had a seizure based on his appearance. The father admitted to LE that he uses Percocet (reported to be prescribed) and THC. He could not produce the medication and/or bottle at that time. Mr. [REDACTED] was arrested on an unrelated warrant related to a misdemeanor charge/failure to appear.

Additional notes:

The sibling, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] is currently at the home of the mother's cousin. The mother asked cousin to care for [REDACTED] while she process what has happened to [REDACTED]. TL [REDACTED] confirmed with Det. [REDACTED] that there is no current suspicion of abuse or neglect. The ME suspects that the child may have ingested something, but there is no evidence currently to support that suspicion. An autopsy will be completed on the child. Investigation is ongoing pending autopsy findings.

On October 3, 2023, the Department of Childrens Services (DCS) received a referral for an allegation of Abuse Death regarding Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] (1). The alleged perpetrator was unknown at the time of the referral but was later identified as birth father, [REDACTED]. This investigation was assigned to Case Manager (CM) [REDACTED] by Team Leader (TL) [REDACTED]. This case was worked in conjunction with Detective [REDACTED] in the Youth Services Division of the [REDACTED] Police Department ([REDACTED] PD).

[REDACTED] (1) lived at home with birth mother, [REDACTED]. Also in the home is sibling; [REDACTED] (3).

On October 3, 2023, [REDACTED] was found unresponsive at the home of his father, [REDACTED]. The father called 911 after finding [REDACTED] unresponsive at the home. The exact time [REDACTED] was found unresponsive is unknown. It is unknown where in the home [REDACTED] was found unresponsive. [REDACTED] was reportedly last seen awake by his father at around 10:00 p.m. on October 2, 2023. [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] Medical Center via ambulance at around 3:00 a.m. on October 3, 2023. On October 4, 2023, CM [REDACTED] spoke with the ACV's sibling, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (3). [REDACTED] did not give any indication he had ever seen anyone using any type of substances. [REDACTED] is a very young child so not much information was able to be obtained. [REDACTED] did not disclose any knowledge that his brother was given or had taken any type of medication, and he did not disclose that any harm was inflicted on his brother or himself.

On February 26, 2024, the final autopsy was received for [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. The autopsy stated, The decedent was a 22-month-old male who found unresponsive. The cause of death is toxic effect of fentanyl and metonitazene. The manner of death could not be determined.

On November 21, 2023, father, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was charged with child neglect, criminal homicide, theft, and failure to appear and currently still in [REDACTED] County Jail awaiting court February 27, 2025. During the investigation, the father admitted to being negligent and reckless by using fentanyl on the bed, which his son was old enough to crawl onto and the grand jury agreed he should be charged with homicide.

On February 27, 2024, CM [REDACTED] presented this case to the [REDACTED] County Child Protective Investigative Team (CPIT). Those in attendance were TL [REDACTED] Detective [REDACTED] ADA [REDACTED] CAC Representative [REDACTED]. The team agreed that there is a preponderance of evidence that supports the substantiation of the Abuse Death.

Per DCS Policy Work Aid 1 Section E: Child Death is defined as:

- a) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect.
- b) Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report.
- c) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect resulting from the parent or caretakers failure to stop another persons direct action that resulted in the death of the child. Child deaths are always treated as severe abuse.

There is a preponderance of evidence that supports the substantiation for all allegations against [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. This case is being classified as Allegation Substantiated, Perpetrator Substantiated for Drug Exposed Child and Abuse Death against [REDACTED] [REDACTED].

The Abuse Death investigation regarding Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was debriefed with the following staff: Case Manager (CM) [REDACTED] Team Leader (TL) [REDACTED] Team Coordinator (TC) [REDACTED] CPS Director (CPSD) [REDACTED], and Director of Critical Incident Support (DCIS) [REDACTED].

The CPS investigation was assigned on 10/3/23 concerning the death of ACV [REDACTED] (1yo). It was reported [REDACTED] primarily resided with his birth mother [REDACTED] and sibling [REDACTED] 3yo] in [REDACTED] County. The birth father [REDACTED] reportedly had casual, sporadic, and infrequent visitation with both children, although he is not the father of the sibling. There is DV history with the parents and they have reportedly been separated for over a year.

The mother reported she dropped the children off at the fathers home on the morning of 10/2/23. The father agreed to keep the children overnight as the mother was starting a new job. The mother stated she went inside briefly when dropping off the children and had no concerns. On the morning of 10/3/23 between approximately 2-3am, the father found [REDACTED] unresponsive and called 911. EMS responded and although no marks, bruises, or injuries were observed, [REDACTED] tongue was reported to be protruding with him biting down on it, indicative of a possible seizure. It is unknown if the seizure was natural or the result of exposure to drugs or some other substance in the home. [REDACTED] was transported to [REDACTED] ER where pronounced deceased and noted rigor mortis had set in. The mother reported there were no medical concerns for [REDACTED] other than having a genetic marker for sickle cell.

Due to outstanding warrants for failure to appear the father was arrested and remains jailed currently. The father reported Percocet and THC use, but none were found in the home. The mother denied any knowledge or concerns of drugs in the fathers home. The 3yo sibling is back in the mothers home and care. He and the home have been observed with no immediate concerns. She has agreed to no future contact between [REDACTED] father and the sibling through a NCPP at this time. Detailed information regarding the siblings father is unknown at this time, but the mother reports no established relationship or contact. CM is unaware if the father was drug screened by LE. Mother requested assistance with grief counseling for herself and the sibling and with funeral costs for [REDACTED].

The father was not allowed to go to the emergency room when [REDACTED] was taken to the hospital. It is believed the father is currently being questioned about the incident by Law Enforcement.
