Providence, R.I. (March 10, 2023) — The Department of Children, Youth & Families (DCYF) is disclosing the fatality of a 1.5-year-old infant from Cranston. The Department had no previous involvement with the family.

The incident occurred on January 19, 2023. The Department initiated an investigation and through this investigation, determined neglect contributed to this fatality. Pursuant to state law, DCYF has notified the Office of the Child Advocate of the report.

Due to confidentiality laws, DCYF is prohibited from sharing additional information.

DCYF's highest priority is the safety and well-being of all children. Rhode Islanders are required by law to report known or suspected cases of child abuse or neglect to DCYF within 24 hours of becoming aware of such abuse/neglect.
