Circumstances: A 5-year-old girl died from a gunshot wound. She lived with her parents and siblings. On the day of the fatality, the child and the mother were home alone. At some point, the father was unable to get in contact with the mother, so he sent relatives to check on her. The mother and child were found deceased from an apparent murder/suicide. The mother had been depressed and received mental health treatment but was not consistent with taking her medication.
