Preliminary Circumstances: Police responded on a Thursday afternoon to a report of a 10-month-old infant found unresponsive along the 1800 block of Gola Drive in Fayetteville, North Carolina. The child, whose name was withheld due to age protections, was transported to Cape Fear Valley Medical Center, where he later died from his injuries. Following an investigation, officers obtained warrants and arrested the father, 23-year-old Trenton Terrell Powell, charging him with first-degree murder and felony child abuse, inflicting serious physical injury. Powell is being held without bond at the Cumberland County Detention Center.
