Preliminary Circumstances: Three children under the age of five died in a residential fire on Grimsley Street in Greensboro, North Carolina, after being left home alone. The fire led to carbon monoxide poisoning that claimed their lives. Their mother, Brandi Sturdivant, has been charged with child abuse and second-degree murder. An investigation by the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services also revealed failures in safety procedures by the Guilford County Department of Social Services, prompting a corrective action plan.
