Preliminary Circumstances: On May 2, 2022, Asheville police responded to a welfare check at the Rodeway Inn on Crowell Road and found the body of a three-year-old boy. The child was reportedly staying at the hotel with his mother, Chantrarica Nasha Matthews (29), and grandmother, Inga Torrence Matthews (50), both of whom were charged with first-degree murder, felony child abuse, and concealment of death. Investigators stated that the child appeared extremely malnourished and had allegedly been starved to death.
