This report, prepared pursuant to section 20(5) of the Social Services Law (SSL), concerns:
☐ A report made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment (SCR) involving the death of a child.
⊠ The death of a child for whom child protective services has an open case.
☐ The death of a child whose care and custody or custody and guardianship has been transferred to an authorized agency
⊠ The death of a child for whom the local department of social services has an open preventive service case.

The Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) is mandated by section 20 of the SSL to investigate or cause for the investigation of the cause and circumstances surrounding the death, review such investigation, and prepare and issue a fatality report in regard to the categories of deaths noted above involving a child, except where a local or regional fatality review team issues a report, as authorized by law.

Such report must include: the cause of death; the identification of child protective or other services provided or actions taken regard to such child and child's family; any extraordinary or pertinent information concerning the circumstances of the child's death; whether the child or the child's family received assistance, care or services from the social services district prior to the child's death; any action or further investigation undertaken by OCFS or the social services district since the child's death; and as appropriate, recommendations for local or state administrative or policy changes.

This report contains no information that would identify the deceased child, his or her siblings, the parent, parents, or other persons legally responsible for the child, and any members of the deceased child's household.

By statute, this report will be forwarded to the social services district, chief county executive officer, chairperson of the local legislative body of the county where the child died and the social services district that had legal custody of the child, if different. Notice of the issuance of this report will be sent to the Speaker of the Assembly and the Temporary President of the Senate of the State of New York.

This report may <u>only</u> be disclosed to the public by OCFS pursuant to section 20(5) of the SSL. It may be released by OCFS only after OCFS has determined that such disclosure is not contrary to the best interests of the deceased child's siblings or other children in the household.



OCFS' review included an examination of actions taken by individual caseworkers and supervisors within the social services district and agencies under contract with the social services district. The observations and recommendations contained in this report reflect OCFS' assessment and the performance of these agencies.

### **Presenting Information**

On 6/6/2022, the NYC Regional Office was notified, via the 7065 Agency Reporting Form, of the death of the 1-day-old subject child that occurred on 6/4/2022. The subject child was born on 6/3/2022, at 25 weeks gestation, and the subject mother tested positive for cocaine and benzodiazepines at the time of the birth. On 6/4/2022, the subject child coded while at the hospital, medical staff attempted CPR and efforts were unsuccessful. The subject child was pronounced deceased at 1:00 PM. The 8-year-old and 16-year-old surviving siblings were removed and placed with a relative due to concerns for the mother's substance abuse.

#### **Executive Summary**

This report regards the death of the 1-day-old male subject child which occurred on 6/4/2022. At the time of the subject child's death, he resided with his mother, biological father, and surviving siblings aged 8-years-old and 16-years-old. The mother, the 16-year-old surviving sibling, the 8-year-old surviving sibling, and that sibling's biological father, were receiving court-ordered preventive services at the time of the death. There was an order of protection in place against the 8-year-old sibling's biological father and he had court-ordered visitation with the 8-year-old sibling, monitored by the New York City Administration for Children's Services (ACS). The 16-year-old sibling visited with his father as agreed upon by the parents.

On 6/3/2022, ACS received an SCR report which alleged the subject child was born that day and the child and mother tested positive for cocaine and benzodiazepines at the time of the birth. The subject child was born premature at 25 weeks gestation. On 6/4/2022, ACS was notified the subject child had passed away at the hospital.

The mother admitted to cocaine use in the days leading up to the birth, during which time she had been the sole caretaker of the surviving siblings. The mother planned for the surviving siblings to stay with their maternal aunt during her hospital stay. On 6/6/2022, ACS filed a neglect petition against the mother and the biological father of the subject child, as he had been determined to be a person legally responsible for the surviving siblings. ACS removed the surviving siblings from their mother's custody on 6/7/2022, and the children remained in the home of their maternal aunt, who had previously been a kinship resource for the 16-year-old sibling. An order of protection was issued by the family court barring the mother from unsupervised contact with the surviving siblings and barring the biological father of the subject child from any contact with the surviving siblings.

The record does not reflect if an autopsy was performed and does not reflect any contact or attempt at contact with the medical examiner or law enforcement. The record reflected the subject child was born severely premature and was in critical condition; however, the record does not reflect a conversation was had with medical or hospital staff to determine the cause of death.

As the subject child's death was not reported to the SCR, there were no allegations of DOA/Fatality to be determined. The investigation open at the time of the fatality regarded allegations of substance misuse against the mother. Those allegations of Parent's Drug / Alcohol Misuse were indicated against the mother regarding the subject child and both surviving siblings. The determination notes the mother tested positive for cocaine and benzodiazepines when the subject child was born and admitted to using cocaine during the pregnancy, at which time she was the sole caretaker for the surviving siblings.

Services were provided to the mother regarding her mental health concerns, substance misuse issues, and parenting abilities. Services were provided to the surviving siblings and they were referred to mental health counseling after the death of the subject child.

# LDSS Response

Upon learning of the subject child's death, ACS investigated the circumstances surrounding the subject child's death by interviewing the mother, the biological father of the subject child, and the 8-year-old and 16-year-old surviving siblings. ACS made collateral contacts with relatives, hospital staff, and service providers as appropriate. ACS notified the New York City Regional Office of the death of the child in an open investigation.

ACS interviewed the mother alone at the hospital after the subject child's birth. The mother admitted to cocaine use in the days leading up to the subject child's birth but denied using benzodiazepines. The mother reported she was unaware of the pregnancy until recently and, as such, did not seek out prenatal care.

ACS attempted to interview the biological father of the subject child who was uncooperative and declined to answer

questions for ACS. ACS interviewed the father of the 8-year-old surviving sibling who reported he was unaware of the mother's substance use while she was pregnant and stated he did not learn about this until after the subject child was born. ACS made efforts to interview the biological father of the 16-year-old surviving sibling; however, he did not engage with ACS.

The maternal aunt and maternal step-uncle were certified as foster parents. The surviving siblings remained in the care of the maternal aunt and uncle and were assessed to be safe in their care.

### **Report Summary:**

The SCR report alleged the mother had given birth to the subject child that day and that at the time of the birth, the mother tested positive for cocaine and benzodiazepines. The subject child was born at 25 weeks gestation and remained in the NICU. The roles of the biological father as well as the 8yo and 16yo surviving siblings were unknown.

**Report Determination:** Indicated **Date of Determination:** 07/26/2022

### **Basis for Determination:**

ACS interviewed the mother, who admitted to using cocaine in the days leading up to the birth of the SC. The allegations of Parent's Drug / Alcohol Misuse were substantiated against the mother regarding all three of her children. The subject child died at the hospital on 6/4/2022 and the surviving siblings were removed from the mother and placed in a kinship foster care setting with their maternal aunt and her husband.

#### **OCFS Review Results:**

ACS did not speak with pertinent collaterals such as hospital staff, the medical examiner, or other medical professionals regarding the mother's substance misuse and if that may have had an effect on the subject child's premature birth or subsequent death. ACS did not add the biological fathers of the surviving siblings to the case composition and did not provide them notification of the SCR report in writing.

### Issue:

Failure to provide notice of report

The biological fathers of the surviving siblings were not added to the investigation, nor were they provided written notice of the report.

### **Issue:**

Adequacy of Risk Assessment Profile (RAP)

### Summary:

The mother reported a mental health diagnosis as well as mobility issues related to a diagnosed medical condition, neither of which were documented in the Risk Assessment Profile. There was no secondary caretaker identified when it was known that the biological father of the subject child had a regular caretaking role for the surviving siblings.

### **Report Summary:**

The SCR report alleged the mother was misusing substances and was unable to adequately care for the then 8-year-old and 16-year-old surviving siblings. The report alleged there was not adequate food or clothing in the home for the children, the 16-year-old would be bullied due to the condition of his clothes, and both children would miss meals and go hungry.

**Report Determination:** Indicated **Date of Determination:** 12/13/2021

### **Basis for Determination:**

Through investigation, ACS found the home to be in deplorable condition with no appropriate sleeping arrangement for the 16-year-old surviving sibling. Interviews with the children and contact with collaterals showed there was a lack of food in the home for the children. The mother and children denied any substance misuse for the mother; however, the mother failed to attend multiple toxicology screenings despite agreeing to do so. The determination notes the allegations of Emotional Neglect were unfounded as the 16-year-old sibling reported having a close and healthy relationship with his mother

### **OCFS Review Results:**

ACS conducted a thorough investigation, interviewed the family and relevant collaterals, and documented their investigatory efforts timely. ACS documented the mother's substance abuse history and her failure to submit to a toxicology screen, and referred the mother for substance abuse services. Frequent home visits were made to ensure the

home remained safe and appropriate for the children. ACS appropriately conferenced the case and coordinated services with existing service providers.

### Report Summary:

The SCR report alleged the then 7-year-old and 15-year-old surviving siblings had excessive school absences and were failing as a result. Both children missed over 40 days of school and had a history of poor attendance. The mother was aware of the children's absences and failed to ensure they attended school. The mother also allowed the 15-year-old child to get a tattoo on his body.

**Report Determination:** Unfounded **Date of Determination:** 07/30/2021

### **Basis for Determination:**

The allegations of Educational Neglect and Inadequate Guardianship were unsubstantiated against the mother regarding both surviving siblings. The determination noted school staff reported no concerns regarding the children to ACS. Regarding the 15-year-old sibling's tattoo, the determination noted the mother allowed the child to get a tattoo to commemorate his grandmother's recent passing.

### **OCFS Review Results:**

The case record does not reflect pertinent information was gathered to determine the allegations of educational neglect. ACS gathered attendance records for only May and June 2021 regarding the then 15-year-old-sibling and gathered no school documentation pertaining to the then 7-year-old sibling. The biological fathers of the siblings were spoken with; however, neither were added to the case, nor were they provided notification of the report in writing.

### **Report Summary:**

The SCR report alleged the biological father of the then 6-year-old surviving sibling physically attacked the mother in the presence of the 6-year-old.

**Report Determination:** Indicated **Date of Determination:** 07/08/2020

### **Basis for Determination:**

Through investigation, ACS learned the biological father of the 6-year-old sibling had a verbal argument with the mother and refused to leave her home. The father pushed the mother with enough force to break her bed and further attacked the mother. The mother called 911 and the 6-year-old child could be heard in the background yelling for her father to stop. The father was intoxicated at the time of the incident. The father was arrested and an order of protection was put in place, barring him from contact with the mother. ACS appropriately substantiated the allegations of Inadequate Guardianship and Parent's Drug / Alcohol Misuse against the father.

## **OCFS Review Results:**

ACS conducted a thorough investigation, interviewing family members and collaterals to gather pertinent information. Referrals for services were made as appropriate. ACS filed a neglect petition in family court against the father and requested orders of protection against him protecting both children, which were granted.

### **Report Summary:**

The SCR report alleged the mother was misusing substances in the presence of, and while the sole caretaker to, the then 6-year-old and 13-year-old siblings.

Report Determination: Unfounded Date of Determination: 11/18/2019

### **Basis for Determination:**

The determination notes the mother was prescribed a controlled substance due to a diagnosed medical condition. The mother submitted to two toxicology screenings. An initial screening was inconclusive due to a diluted sample and the subsequent screening was negative for all substances other than the mother's prescribed medication. Both siblings were interviewed and reported no knowledge of their mother misusing substances. A family services stage was opened for the purposes of holding a family team meeting in an attempt to provide services to the family; however, those services were declined.

ACS made home visits, conducted interviews, contacted collaterals, and provided services to the family as appropriate. The biological fathers of both surviving siblings were not added to the case nor were they provided notification of the report. ### CPS - Investigative History More Than Three Years Prior to the Fatality

The mother and the biological father of the 8-year-old surviving sibling have CPS history dating back to 2012 with common concerns of substance misuse. Both were named as subjects on a 9/1/2012 SCR report with substantiated allegations of Inadequate Guardianship, Parent's Drug and Alcohol Misuse, and Inadequate Food Clothing and Shelter regarding the now 16-year-old surviving sibling. An SCR report dated 10/15/2013 similarly contains substantiated allegations against both parents for Inadequate Guardianship regarding the now 8-year-old surviving sibling. The mother alone was listed as a subject on an SCR report dated 8/12/2014 with substantiated allegations of Parent's Drug and Alcohol Misuse regarding both surviving siblings. Both parents are listed as subjects on similar SCR reports received 5/9/2015, 7/13/2015, and 2/26/2018 for allegations substance misuse and lack of supervision which were unsubstantiated.

### **Preventive Services History**

A Preventive Services case was opened 6/9/2020 due to concerns for substance misuse and domestic violence in the home and in the presence of the surviving siblings. The biological father of the 8-year-old surviving sibling had attacked the mother while under the influence of substances in the presence of the child. The father was arrested and a stay away order was put in place to protect the mother only. ACS filed a neglect petition against the father requesting an order of protection to protect the children as well as court-ordered services, which were granted. Services were provided by a community agency with oversight by ACS. Appropriate services were referred for all family members, though the father only fitfully engaged with the services. The Preventive Services case remained open at the time of the fatality after which the surviving siblings were removed from the mother and placed in kinship foster care with their maternal aunt.

### **Foster Care Placement History**

On 9/13/2012, the now 16-year-old surviving sibling was removed from his mother and placed in kinship foster care with his maternal aunt pursuant to concerns for the mother and the biological father of the now 8-year-old sibling misusing substances to the point they were unable to care for the child. The mother and father were court ordered to engage with substance misuse treatment services and parenting classes; however, only the mother engaged with those services. Upon the birth of the now 8-year-old surviving sibling on 10/14/2013, that child was removed and placed with the maternal aunt; however, both children were returned to the mother shortly thereafter on 10/22/2013.
