The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professionals to complete the assessment. The Medical Examiner's Office determined the death was non-accidental. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the child by the father's significant other. The child's sibling was deemed unsafe, taken into Temporary Physical Custody, and placed in a non-relative foster home. A Child in Need of Protection or Services Petition was filed, and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management
